Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and with all voting in favor the R. & B. Special money in the amount of \$7073.11 was divided as follows.

R. & B. # 1 - 22%	R. & B. # 3 - 20%
R. & B. # 2 - 27%	R. & B. # 4 - 31%

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous consent the court approved the bonds for John McGee and Alton McClelland as Independent Public Weighers.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to split the Revenue Sharing money in the amount of \$15,665.26 equally between the four Commissioners precincts and Administrative Fund.

Motion Carried.

The County Judge brought to the attention of the court that on Feb. 26, 1979 at the request of the court Truett Pritchard appeared before the court and explained the procedure of the Tax Computer System and what it would take to keep the tax statements from being late.

The Company was contacted by phone during the court session, and the company still did not have the statements prepared.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to prepare a statement notice to be published in the Sabine County Reporter to explain to the Tax Payers that the delay in the Tax Statements was due to the Computer Company.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to divide the Federally Owned Entitlement Lands money in the amount of \$31,649.00 equally between the four Commissioners Precincts and Jail Fund. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to start a Library Fund for the County and to be supported by adding to the Court Costs in County and also District Court Cases.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no futher business, the Court adjourned.
