Being all of block Seventeen (17) of the City of Hemphill, Texas, consisting of Lots One (1) Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8) in Block Seventeen (17), all according to the original Map or Plat of said Town of Hemphill, Texas, of record in the County Clerk's office of Sabine County, Texas, and specifically including all improvements situated thereon.

That such loan will be repaid on or before 1 year from date and 6% per annum shall be paid the bank on such loan. Such loan shall be evidenced by the issuance of a time warrant in the amount of \$44,000.00 being 6% interest per annum and being due on or before one year from date.
