Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. that Sabine County Officers and employees will be compensated by Salary for the year 1980. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioners Jimmy Vickers seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to divide the Forest Check in the amount of \$257,087.84 as follows: 50% to the Schools and 50% to County. The following amounts to be transferred to Officers Salary Fund:

Half of this amount being \$27,606.00 to be placed in 6 months Money Market Certificate to be added back to Officers Salary Fund. The balance of the 128,543.92 to be split between the Commissioners Precincts as follows:

R. & B. #1	22%	R. & B. #3	20%
R. & B. #2	27%	R. & B. #4	31%

Motion was approved by the court.

Motion by Commissioners R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting in favor the Road & Bridge Special in the amount of \$10,344.26 was split percentage as above.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting "Aye" the Revenue Sharing in the amount of \$15,521.61 was divided 5 ways equally between the four Commissioner Precincts and Administrative Fund.

Jan Morris representative of Tri County Community Action gave a report to the court concerning work they had done in Sabine County on weatherproofing houses of the elderly and low income families.





Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to give Judge Smith authority to hire or direct Janitor responsibilities in any way he sees fit. Motion carried.


Accounts were allowed and made payable.


Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to adjourn.
