Greg McCoury and W. J. Barlow from the Hemphill City Council met with the Court. They were present to ask the Court that the County provide parking for the Courthouse employees. The place that was suggested to the Court was the property now owned by the County on the North-West side of the Courthouse, referred to as the future jail construction site. The Commissioners Court will work toward this as soon as possible.

A report by Judge Royce C. Smith was given on the assessibility to the Courthouse for the handicapped. Work will start soon on the first floor restrooms. Doorways will be made assessible and a place for the handicapped to park their cars will be desidnated.

Royce C. Smith informed the Court that Kuston Signals (Radar) accepted payments of \$85.20, thus clearing up the account. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to purchase a new radar unit from Decatur Electronics Inc., and payment be made when a satisfactory 2 year warranty could be assured. All voting in favor, Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison that on the recommendation of Judge Royce C. Smith \$10,000.00 from Permanent Improvement, \$15,000.00 from Right-of-Way and \$25,000.00 from General Fund be placed on Saving C. D. with interest rate at the First State Bank for a period of 90 days. With all voting in favor, Motion Carried.

Therebeing no futher business, the Court was adjourned.
