Judge Royce C. Smith presented to the Court a letter of resignation from Deputy Clerk, Mrs. Sandra Easley. See Exhibit "A" following the Court minutes. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith that Mrs. Easley's resignation be accepted. All voting in favor, Motion was Carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to hire Mrs. Terry Lynn Ferguson for the position of Deputy Clerk. All voting "Aye". Motion was carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to consider Walter Henry for the position of Carpenter & Painter. This job will be through and funded by the On The Job Training Program. This will only be if the program has the funds available for our County. Judge Royce C. Smith will check into this matter further.

The Commissioner's Court had set today's Court aside to meet with the public on the spending of money earned by the County from Revenue Sharing. No one was present to meet with the Court on this matter. See Exhibit "B" attached to Court minutes which this matter was placed on the agenda for today's Court.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to hire Kyle Walker for the position vacated by Mr. T. C. Jones, as Veterans Administrator. This motion before the Court was voted on, with the vote being 2 for and 2 against.

With Judge Royce C. Smith voting for the motion, thus breaking the tie. Motion was Carried.

By a recommendation from Commissioner Jimmy Wickers the Court agreed to meet with Mr. Walker before he takes over this office, to discuss what will be expected of him and of his duties in taking over this position.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no futher business, the Court was adjourned.
