On this the 11th day of August, 1980, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

Upon a recommendation by Marie White, Tax Assessor-Collector, Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to hire Shirley Welch to replace Donna Dupre in the tax office effective as of this date at a salary of \$486.49. Second to the motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and all voted in favor.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to set next court day, August 25th for Budget Request for 1981. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and with all voting in favor the following Resolution was adopted. Marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to appoint Perry Sampson to the Board of Directors of Mental Health Mental Retardation Services for a two year term. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to pay Election Judges and Clerks \$30.00 a day for holding the General Election in November. Election Judges to be paid for two days. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to send a resolution to Congressman Charles Wilson, Senators Lloyd Benson and John Tower urging them to pass Senate Bill 2724 to continue the Coop Agreement between the County and Corp of Engineers for sheriff's Department to patrol the Sam Rayburn Parks.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and by unanimous consent of the court the following money was ordered transferred into OSF:

- \$5000 out of Permanent Improvement
- \$10,000 out of Jury
- \$20,000 out of General Co.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to buy 20 chairs and a desk to set up a County Court room on the second floor of the courthouse.

A representative of Temple Associates met with the court with plans for a new jail and discussed with the court the lay out and land scaping needed. Approximate cost to be \$300,000. Since the plans have to be approved by the Jail Commission no action was taken at this time.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

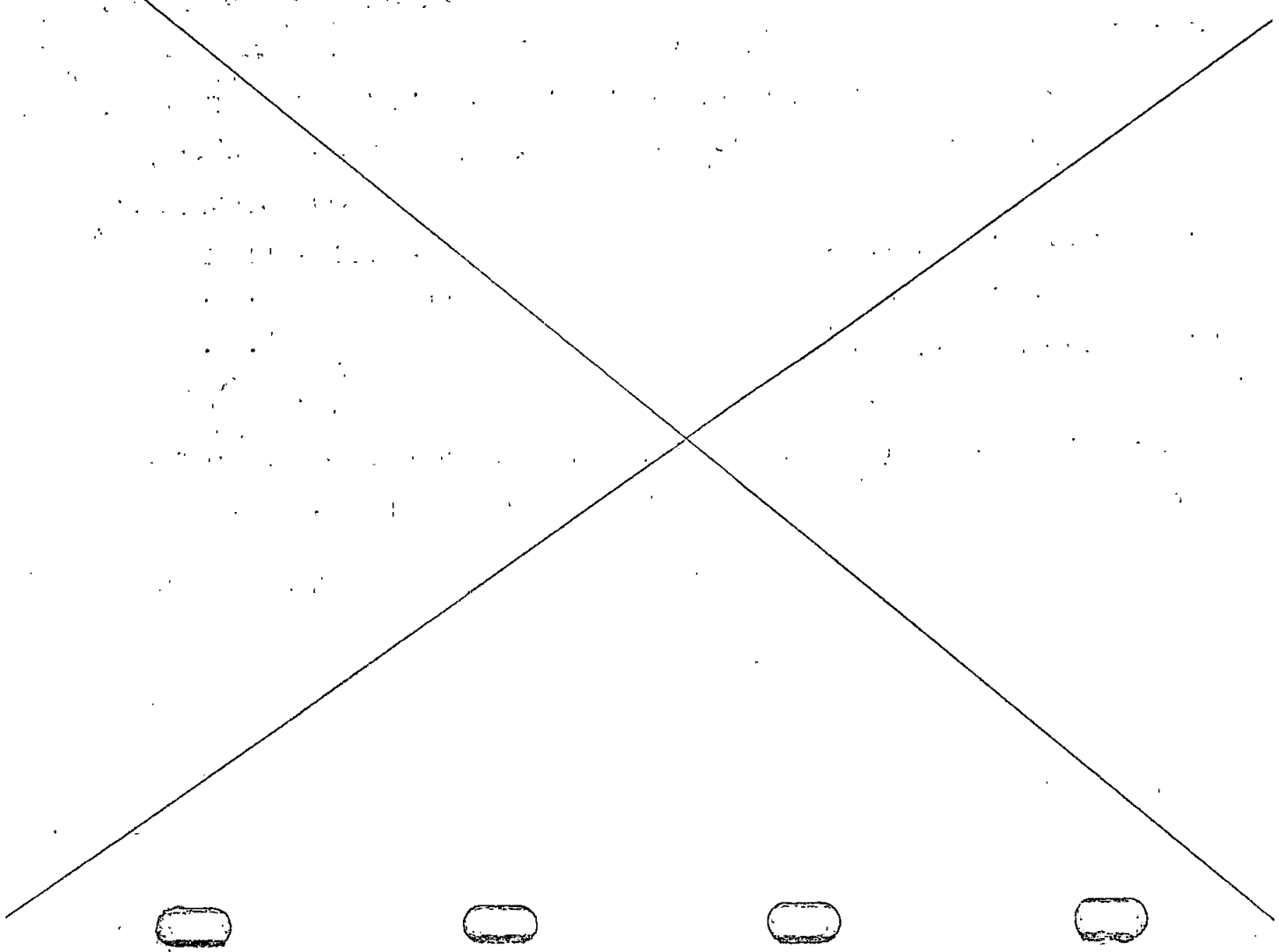

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Sabine County, being a duly constituted member of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments and desirous of participation in those decisions affecting this Region, and

WHEREAS, we recognize the need for low income rental housing subsidies in this County, and throughout the Region, of the type and nature defined in the HUD Section 8 Moderate Rehabilitation Programs, and


WHEREAS, we feel that these needs, which are common to the Region generally, can best be addressed by a Regional approach to this problem.

The award of HUD, to the Deep East Texas Council of Governments: Human Resources Division; those designations, resources and assistance that would enable them to properly initiate and administrate the Section 8 Moderate Rehabilitation Program on a Regional basis.
