
Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to divide R&B Special \$1923.70. Motion carried.


Accounts were allowed and made payable.

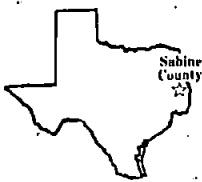

COMMISSIONER, PRECINCT NO. 1

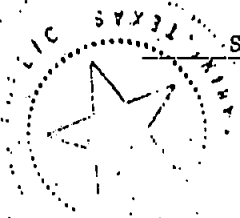
