27% to R. & B. #2

31% to R. & B. #4

All voted in favor of this motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison in order to comply with the minimum wage law it was necessary to raise the salary of Employees making less than \$3.35 effective January 1, 1981. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to divide the R. & B. Special money in the amount of \$6,437.25 as follows: R. & B. #1 - 22% R. & B. #3 - 20%

R. & B. #2 - 27%

R. & B. #4 - 31%

All voted in favor of the motion.

Neil Armstrong appeared before the Court to discuss a road leading into their property. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded R. E. Smith for the county to ask the Forest Service for a road right of way across Forest land. The road would follow the route recommended by the Forest Service. The Court instructed Mr. Armstrong about the construction of the road, 6 inches of compact gravel and after a waiting period of 3 years subject to inspection and approval by the Commissioners court. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to accept the roads for maintenance in Beechwood I, II, III, and IV as agreed in Judgment in Cause No. 8763 in District Court of Sabine County. All voted in favor of the motion.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.
