The U. S. Forest Check of \$4930.08 was voted on to be divided equally. Half of which goes to the schools and the other half to be divided by the commissioners. Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to transfer funds from Permenant Improvement to Officers Salary Fund of \$5000.00 for Custodian and Maintenance upkeep, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith to pay the interest up to February 2, 1981, on note for Jail site property in the amount of \$2748.49 out of General County Fund, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and all voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R.E. Smith to pay \$4000.00 out Revenue Sharing Administrative Fund on the principle of note on Jail property. All noted in favor of the motion. Please see attached "Exhibit B".

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay the office of the County Auditor, Jonetta Nash, \$140.00 per year. Seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell. Motion Carried. Please see attached "Exhibit A"

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay \$6.88 each for eight chairs. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay \$12.00 to \$14.00 to R. D. Griffin for Social Security, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith to have the monthly salary divided into two pay periods starting on the 15th day of February, 1981 and to be paid on the 1st and 15th of the month there after, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith to release Mr. Walter Henry of his duties as Custodion and Mainteance, and replace him with

Mrs. Bernice Davis. Her duties and employment will begin on February 2, 198
Mrs. Davis's salary will be on-the-job training under the Comprehensive
Employment and Training Act. The project will be funded through the Deep I
Council of Governments, which funds will pay 50 percent of the new
Custodians salary up to six months. Seconded by Commissioner Jimmy
Vickers. Motion Carried.
