Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to hire Sandra Easley temporarly for the Tax Office. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay for two Notary Bonds for the Tax Office and Two for the Sheriff's Office. R. E. Smith, Eldridge Ellison and Jimmy Vickers voted for the motion. G. W. Russell, Jr. abstained.

The matter was brought to the attention of the court concerning delinquent taxes on the Ashward Howard place. The Tax Assessor-Collector was instructed to collect what was on the books. All voted in favor of them motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to accept the biddof First State Bank for our County Depository for 1981 and 1982. All voted in favor of the motion.

Mrs. Blanche Toole, Chairman of the Sabine County Historical Committee. She asked that Miss Willie Ragan and Susan Nethery be appointed to this Committee and also that the county help out financially. She also showed a plaque for the courthouse. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to appoint Willie Ragan and Susan Nethery to the Sabine County Historical Commission and to wait on the financial arrangements at this time. All voted in favor of the motion.

Jerald Nichols appeared before the court to discuss "Minton Road". Upon a motion by Commissioer Jimmy Vickers seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison the Forest Service was given permission to surface the above road. See Exhibit "A" attached to minutes of this date.

Jim Stockman with Temple Eastex appeared before the court concerning the Waste Disposals. He told the court deeds would be made to the county for these sites that were already being used.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to approve the Quarterly Report. Motion carried. Quarterly Report is marked "Exhibit B" and attached to minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to divide the R & B Special money in the amount of \$12,470.55 percentage wise between the 4 commissioner precincts.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to reimburse Judge Royce Smith 20¢ per mile for his trips to Austin and Bryan and also his Motel bill. This will also apply to the Clerk's trip to Bryan to the Seminar on March 3rd.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to appoint W. W. Cavender to the Veterans Land Board for Sabine County to replace T. C. Jones who is deceased.

All voted in favor of the motion.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

Said road is further described and depicted on the attached map and marked Exhibit A-1.


