On this the 11th day of May, 1981, the Honorable Commissioners Court met in regular session with the following members present, to-wit:

Mr. Cullen G. Glass, representing the Pendleton Hiway Subdivision Co-Operative Association appeared before the Court in reference to the boat ramp that some of the residents in the Pendleton Harbor Subdivision are trying to have constructed. Mr. Glass and the Association in which he represented is opposed to the boat ramp. The Court informed Mr. Glass that no boat ramp will be built at this time, as the Sabine River Authority would not consent to the ramp being built.

Mr. Clark with the firm of Alexander & Rodgers in Lufkin, Texas appeared before the Court. Mr. Clark stated that his firm would be available to do the County audit for the County, as a audit will have to be done next year if the jail bond is passed. R. E. Smith, Commissioner Precinct No. 1 stated that the County would like to talk to the firm that did the audit for the County in 1977 before making any decision on this matter.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith that the Court write a letter to the Sabine River Authority and the Corp of Engineers stating that the County does not repair boat ramps, and works only County roads excepted for maintenance up to the take line of the lake. With all voting in favor, the motion was carried.

Meigs Building Contractors from Jasper, Texas submitted there bid for the Elevator for the Courthouse. This bid was opened at 10:07 A.M. by Judge Royce C. Smith. Mr. Berry was present to represent the company. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to table this matter until next court meeting, at

which time Mr. Berry will meet with the court again. All voting in favor, the motion was carried. See "Exhibit A"

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to make a Resolution that Sabine County remain in one State Representative District. So be it resolved that Sabine County not be split into two State Representative District's. With all voting in favor, the motion was carried.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. that Sheriff Blan Greer, Deputy Bill Horton and Deputy Billy Don Sparks be compensated \$150.00 each a month for expenses for patrolling of the Parks on Sam Rayburn for the Corp of Engineers. This would be for a total of five months. With all voting in favor, Motion was carried.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no futher business, the Court adjourned.
