Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner
G. W. Russell, Jr. to split R. & B. Special money in the amount
of \$11,681.27 as follows:

27% to R. & B. #2	31% to R. & B. #4

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner
G. W. Russell, Jr. to approve the Quarterly Report for the Second
Quarter, All voted in favor of the motion. See "Exhibit A"
attached to minutes of this date.

The Liability Insurance for Sabine County is with Farmers
Insurance Group. Our original statement for the year 1981 was
in the amount of \$14,324.00. After the audit/^{we}were allowed a credit
of \$2350.00. Since the insurance had been over payed a refund check
in the amount of \$1176.00 was received. Motion by Commissioner
Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to divide this
refund check equally between the four commissioner precincts. All
voted in favor.

Petitions concerning roadway into the Woodland Estates and
Toledo Village were presented to the court. These petitions had
been mailed to the State Department of Highways and Public Trans-
portation. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by
Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting "Aye" these petitions
were entered into the minutes of this court. Marked "Exhibit B"
and attached to minutes of this date.

✓ Randy Blanks, representative of Deep East Texas Council of Governments met with the court concerning the redistricting of Sabine County according to population. No action was taken at this time.

Present with the court for the Expenditures of Revenue Sharing Hearing was Mr. Harold Schorg from Toledo Village. Judge Smith explained what was paid out of the Administrative Account of Revenue Sharing which was general office supplies and for having the 20 new books made for the County Clerk's Office. Each Commissioner said their part was spent for fuel and keeping up their equipment and roads. Mr. Schorg had no request for funds he came to observe the meeting. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to use the money in the same way and divide it as usual being five ways equally. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to abandon 3/4 mile of road called the C. B. Counts loop. All voted in favor of the motion.


Accounts were allowed and made payable.


There being no further business, the court adjourned.
