Judge Smith brought to the attention of the court that some extra help would be needed to clear the Storage room before the Elevator could be installed- removing shelves etc. Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. that Judge Smith see to hiring this extra help and handle as he sees fit. All voted in favor of the motion.

It was discussed in a previous meeting about the amount of Delinquent Taxes and about getting some one to make a list and mail out letters concerning the Delinquent Taxes. After further discussion in todays meeting motion was made by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to hire Freda Chambers to work with the County Judge on this project, effective November 1, at a salary of \$508.08 per month temporary.

In answer to the vote in meeting of October 12, 1981 concerning the McGee road the following letter was received and marked as "Exhibit A" and attached to minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R.E.Smith to divide the Lateral Road money in the amount of \$55,981.14 equally between the four commissioner precincts. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to split the R. & B. Tax in the amount of \$465.77 and R. & B. Special in the amount of \$2,761.91 in the usual way as follows:

22% to R. & B. #1	20% to R. & B. #3
27% to R. & B. #2	31% to R. & B. #4
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All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and by unanimous consent the following Quarterly Report was approved and marked "WExhibit B" and attached to minutes of this date.

Bill Keith, Supervisor of the Child Welfare Board and Mrs. Bennie Barfield, Bookkeeper appeared before the court request financial aid for the Child Welfare. Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to support the same as last year with \$500.00. All voted in favor of this motion.

The above Child Welfare workers were the only ones to appear concerning the Budget Hearing Requests.

E. E. Rogers appeared before the court about garbage disposal for the Brookeland School. He stated the one he had been using in Jasper County had been closed down by the Health Department. Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. whose precinct this is in stated he would do what he could to help them out.



Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R.E. Smith and by unanimous consent the resolution was adopted. Marked "Exhibit C" and attached to minutes of this date. Accounts were allowed and made payable.

We propose to furnish all labor and material to complete the following work to the specifications below for the sum of \$73,000.00.

Install one (1) Westinghouse Model WH 131, 2100 pound Hydraulic Elevator. Shaft to be built inside building, using the first and second floors of the southside storage rooms. The shaft to come through courtroom at the southwest corner on the third floor. The doors are to open into the halls on the first and second floors, and

into the courtroom on the third floor. The elevator shaft is to be made up of 8" haydite blocks. All voids in

the blocks are to be filled with concrete and steel rebars at all corners. openings and support areas. All door openings are to be finished with wood framing. 5/8" sheetrock textured and painted or paneling will be installed to match

All electrical wiring will be encased in steel conduit.

Machine room will be located at the first floor storage room behind the elevator shaft. A door to the machine room will be cut in the west wall All existing steel beams will be cut and supported by shaft wall.

Exterior of shaft will be finished on the third floor only.

Due to heavy construction there will be a great deal of noise and inconvenience inside the courthouse. If it becomes necessary to work while the courthouse is closed there will be an extra charge for overtime
