Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to put this on an optional basis and any one or all All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to adopt the budget. Motion carried.'

Upon a motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and by unanimous consent the bond of Alton McClelland, Public Weigher was approved.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to divide the following money:

U. S. Forest Check in the amount of \$580,803.94% to be divided with the schools which will receive half (\$290,401.97) the Commissioners salaries will be added to the Officers Salary Fund and the balance in the amount of \$220,666.87 will be divided 22% to R. & B. #1, 27% to R. & B. #2, 20% to R. & B. #3 and 31% to R. & B. #4. All voted in favor of this motion.

The R. & B. Tax money in the amount of \$8,913.32 was divided percentage wise between the four commissioners precincts.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business the court adjourned.
