The Forest Service Plans to permit the installation of a cable system by Continental Telephone Company along Forest Service Road #117 and the Scrappin Valley Road, designated as Sabine County Road #5 in the Forest Development Cooperative Agreement between the U. S. Forest Service and Sabine County, dated 1976. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to grant this request, providing and with the condition that the road be left in as good shape as when the project was started and notifying Mr. Russell when the work was to began. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to adopt the following resolution concerning Fire Ants which is marked "Exhibit A" and attached to minutes of this date. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. and by unanimous consent the court agreed to order 6500 pounds of Amdro and 50 quarts of MC96. Mr. Toner, County Agent met with the court to discuss this and said the money would have to be paid before the products were picked up in Austin.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and by unanimous consent the following Resolution was adopted by the Court, which is marked "Exhibit B" and attached to minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, to contact Sabine River Authority and find out if they have a Right Of Way into Norvell McGee property and find out if it is still in effect and if not how it could be re-instated. All voted in favor of this motion.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

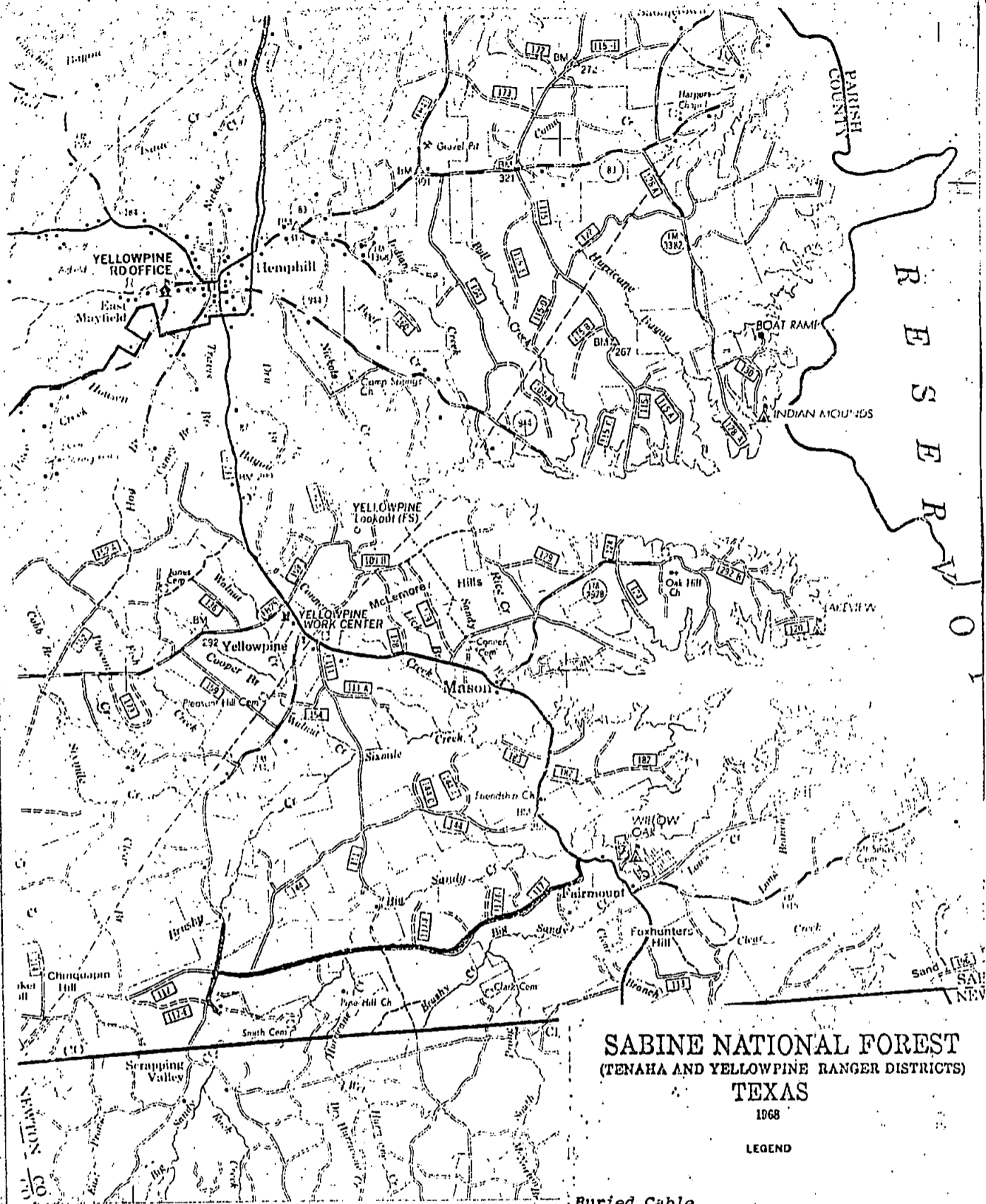

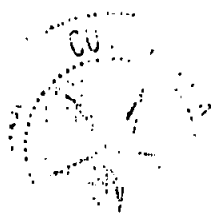
