Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner G.W. Russell, Jr. to approve Plat of Mary J. Brumly Survey of 10 acres, Davidson Tract. All voted in favor of this motion.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to hire Freda Chambers as deputy County & District Clerk on the recommendation of Minnie Gooch County & District Clerk, diffective May 1, 1982 at a salary of \$558.89.

Mr. Ercil Langham representing American Security Insurance met with the court and presented an insurance plan for Hospitalization Insurance. No action was taken at this time.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to set May 10, 1982 to open bids for Group Hospital the Insurance for county employees and that/## public be notified by advertisement in Sabine County Reporter. Motion carried.

James Lawrence met with the court concerning fencing of a Public road to Rebel Ridge known as the old King Goodrich road. Commissioner R. E. Smith stated that it was a county road and it had not been abandoned. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to ask the Sheriff's Department to go down and ask that the fence be removed. All voted in favor of this motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to divide the Revenue Sharing money in the amount of \$13,206.46 as follows: \$5000.00 to Revenue Sharing Administrative fund and the balance four ways equally between the four commissioner precincts.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to divide the R. & B. Tax in the amount of \$2,968.75 and R. & B. Special in the amount of \$8,992.25 percentage wise between the four commissioner precincts. Motion carried.

Accounts were allowed and made payable.
