On this the 14th day of July, 1982, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in Special Session with the following members present, to-wit:



The Court discussed the county finances particularly the bills turned in by Lucky Crain for R & B #2. It was determined that some of these bills dated back to 1980. Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay the two bills dated 2-18-82 for \$132.50 and 3-22-82 for \$437.14 making a total paid out of \$569.64. Second to the motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers and all voted in favor of the motion.


