On this the 26th day of July, 1982, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session with the following members present, to-wit:

Mr. C. E. Hartfield appeared before the court, representing Beechwood I, concerning a bill in the amount of \$450.00 for Treated Rock which was paid out of the Beechwood account/ to C. & B. Truck & Material Service Carmichael Marina had contributed \$150.00 toward this bill and Fairdale Church had contributed \$150.00 and County of sabine was to have paid the other \$150.00. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to reimburse \$150.00 to Beechwood account out of R. & B. #2. Motion carried.

Mr. Hartfield also stated another bill in the amount of \$354.16 to Trotti & Thomson for Asphalt was paid out of Beechwood I account in error. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to reimburse Beechwood I \$354.16 when money becomes available in R. & B. #2. All voted in favor of this motion.

A bill presented for payment for 60 yds. of Ironore from Arney's Concrete in the amount of \$60.00 was brought to the attention of the court. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay this bill when money becomes available in R. & B. #2. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to amend first motion of payment of \$150.00 to Beechwood to pay when funds become available in R. & B. #2. Motion carried.

Upon a recommendation by Mr. C. E. Hartfield, motion was made by Commissioner G. W. Russell, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith that

One of the following signatures appear on the bill for Beechwood I before it is presented to the court for payment: O. E. Scoggins, Archie McKinney or C. E. Hartfield. Bills must be presented to the court before payment is made. All voted in favor of this motion.

Shirley Stevens appeared before the court concerning the closing of the portion of road at Alpine Fly Inn which was brought before the court on May 24, 1982 and June 28, 1982 and which notices of the meeting was published in Sabine County Reporter for July 26, 1982.

Mr. Wiggins appeared before the court and spoke on behalf of not closing this road at Alpine Fly Inn.

Dare Hawkins an attorney out of Houston also appeared before the court concerning the same road at Alpine Fly Inn. He is presently the owner of Alpine Fly Inn. He wanted the road closed.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers that FM road #242 has an 80 ft. Right Of Way and that the 80 ft ROW be left free and clear of obstructions or any signs except road instruction signs. All voted in favor of the motion.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith that ^{the county of Sabine} disallows any claims to these roads in Alpine Fly Inn property (52 acres) except for FM road #242. Voting for the motion were R. E. Smith, Eldridge Ellison and Jimmy Vickers. Voting against the motion was G. W. Russell, Jr.

Invoice for Financial Advisory Fee from Schneider, Bernet & Hickman, Inc. was brought before the court. There had been some question as to the cost of the Election being deducted from the fee before payment. County Attorney R. Earl Lord being present with the court was asked for his Legal opinion as to Election Supplies as stated on the invoice in the amount of \$146.00 and Election Expenses which would include Election Judges and Election Clerks as well as ballots. Mr. Lord stated that we would have to go by the Contract which said Election Expenses. Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay this bill less the total expense of the Bond Election. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R.E. Smith that the court give permission and authorize county Judge to sign request for Continental Telephone Company to bury cable along Sabine County Road #7 (Clarktown). All voted in favor of this motion. Marked "Exhibit A" and attached to minutes of this date.

On August 31, 1982 Mr. Perry Sampson will complete his second two-year term on the Board of Trustees. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to re-appoint him for another term as Board Member to the Deep East Texas Regional MHMR Services. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay #### Architect for Jail payment in the amount of \$8100.00. Motion carried.

Dues to the Deep East Texas County Commissioners & County Judges Association in the amount of \$600.00 Minimum and \$1000.00 Maximum was due to be paid. Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay \$300.00 now and pledge \$300.00 more to be paid in November. All voted in favor of the motion.

A. W. Davis, County Attorney Pro Tem for the months of 9-1-81 through 4-1-82 sent bill in the amount of \$2291.22 which would have been County Attorneys base salary. Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay Mr. Davis out of the Jury fund. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to pay the bill in the amount of \$568.75 to Texas Department of Corrections for the refinishing of furniture for the courthouse. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to transfer \$1000.00 from Permanent Improvement Fund into Officers Salary Fund for custodian salary. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to split the Revenue Sharing money/in the following in amount of \$13,343.06 ways: \$5000.00 into Administrative Fund to pay on Elevator; the balance to be divided equally between the four commissioner precincts. All voted in favor of the motion.

Bids as advertised for Air Conditioning and Heating the District Court room, District Clerk office and Jury room were opened at this time. There were three bids presented: Higginbotham, San Augustine, Texas was for \$9,895.00; Anderson Air Conditioning, Hemphill, Texas for \$6,165.00 and Sans Foix, Inc., Hemphill, Texas for \$8,400.00. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to take the 3 bids under consideration until next court day. All voted in favor of this motion.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers to divide the R. & B. Tax in the amount of \$310.99 and the R. & B. Special in the amount of \$4,995.82 in the following ways:

- R. & B. #1 - 22%
- R. & B. #2 - 27%
- R. & B. #3 - 20%
- R. & B. #4 - 31%

Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to publish notices in the paper for public input Revenue Sharing for Budget for 1983. Motion carried.

Accounts and salaries were allowed and made payable.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

If this project meets with your approval, please indicate by signing and returning this letter along with a list of requirements that would be necessary to project activities along Sabine County Road #7.



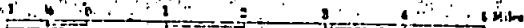
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SABINE NATIONAL FOREST
