Mr. A. L. Fruge appeared before the Court on the road known as the Gooch-Point Road. Mr. Fruge ask that the court accept the road for maintenance. Motion was made by Commissioner, G. W. Russell, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to accept the road as a county road after three years, if at that time all specifications are met and approved by the court. With all voting in favor of this motion, Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to transfer \$750.00 from Jury Fund into General County Fund. This being the money paid to Mr. James Allen Payne on July 12, 1982, his attorneys fee for representing the county in a law suit. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to call a meeting for September 22, 1982 at 8:30 A.M. to discuss the 1983 budget. All voted in favor, Motion Carried.

Jim Nethery, Chief Appraiser with the Appraisal Dist. Board met with the court. He explained the tax rate and how it was based. County tax value will be around 152 million, after exemptions, according to Mr. Nethery.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. to approve plat on Arrowcrest Subdivision, submitted by Billy Joe McGee. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to abandon for maintenance the road from Sexton to East Hamilton from the East side of Hwy. 87 to Patroon Creek. With Commissioners R. E. Smith, Eldridge Ellison and Jimmy Vickers voting for the motion and Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. voting against, the motion was carried. There being no further business the court adjourned.
