Motion by Commissioner G. W. Russell, Jr. seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison that since the money had been on hand since 6 or 7 years that a notice be published in the paper giving 90 days for the people to let us know if they wanted their money back or to give it to the Youth Foundation. Motion carried.

Mr. Bill Ross appeared before the court concerning Starr Cable TV. He left AGREEMENT FOR STAR CATV INVESTMENT CORP. TO USE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY, SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS for the court to study and he asked to be placed on the Agenda for November 8, 1982 at the Regular meeting.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay the matching grant in the amount of \$2,875.00 for the Teletype machine for the sheriff's office. Motion carried.

Advance Construction requested payment for Jail Construction in the amount of \$15,427.00. Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to pay this amount. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Jimmy Vickers, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to approve a Resolution to authorize filing of a Community Development Block Grant Application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Marked Exhibit "A" and attached to minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to transfer Interest money on unused money for Jail to General County Fund. The amount being \$3,157.99. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to split the R. & B. Special money in the amount of \$8,090.16 percentage wise between the four commissioner precincts. Motion carried.

WHEREAS, it is both necessary and in the best public interest that Sabine County, Texas, make every effort to avail itself of the 1982 Community Development Block Grant Program for Non-Metropolitan Discretionary Grants, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS:

A Single Purpose grant for: Improvements to the "Geneva Community Center and to those county roads specified at a Public Hearing" to allow area residents suitable access to the center and to provide safe, effective vehicular circulation in the area.


