

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On this the 14th day of March, 19 83, at a Regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, there came on for consideration the making of a contract for the collection of delinquent taxes, and motion was made by Billy Joe McGee County Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, seconded by Chester D. Cox County Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, that subject to approval by the State Property Tax Board and Attorney General of Texas said Commissioners' Court in behalf said County do make and enter into a contract with Edwin R. York, Jr. a licensed attorney, for the latter to collect delinquent taxes in said County for 20 % of the amount of taxes, penalty and interest collected, said contract to end on the 31st day of December, 19 84, with six months thereafter to complete pending suits, and to be on forms currently promulgated and recommended by the State Property Tax Board.

Said motion being put to vote, it carried by a vote of 4 to 0.
