This being a total of 1,529 votes which the county cast for the Appraisal District Board of Directors. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to declare November 11,1983 as a county Holiday. All voted in favor of this motion. Motion Carried.
