Bills were examined and made ready for payment. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay the bills. Motion Carried.

Motion By Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to approve the Quarterly report. Motion Carried. Exhibit C

The votes were canvased that was cast on November 8, 1983 in the Constitutional Amendment Election. Motion by Commissioner Eldridge, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to approve the number of votes. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Jr. to accept the provisions contained in Minute Order No. 81351 00027 by the State Highway and Public Transportation Commission on October 26, 1983, for the Improvement by the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation on two County roads. All voted in favor, motion carried. See "Exhibibt A " attached to the court minutes.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to appoint Ms. Blanche Toole as Chairman to the State Sesquicentennial Commission. All voting in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox Jr. to appoint Mr. Wayne Mote, Ms. Doris McDowell & Ms. Elaine Hussey to the County Child Welfare Board. Motion Carried.

Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Jr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, to pass the resolution to make application for a Capacity Building grant allocated from the Texas Community Development Program funds under the terms and conditions of the State of Texas. See attached "Exhibit B" to the court minutes. Motion Carried.

Mr. Claude Vickers met with the court & addressed the court on his personal property taxes. Mr. Vickers asked the court for a copy of the financial report and a copy of the receipts and disbursements for the county. At this time he was given a copy of these reports. Mr. Vickers advised the court that a group of county residents would like to meet with the court at a later date. Mr. Vickers also stated to the court that the tax office should have posted a notice in the tax office and published a notice in the paper on a error made by the computer on the tax statements for this year.

Mr. & Mrs. Forrest Perkins from Sam Rayburn Estates met with the court. Mr. Perkins asked Commissioner McGee about the iron ore, which is to be applied to the road by Commissioner Harlem Hall of San Augustine County. Commissioner McGee stated that as soon as the iron ore was delivered he would send a machine to help apply and repair the road.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

In SABINE COUNTY a FARM TO MARKET ROAD is hereby designated extending from Farm to Market Road 2928, 0.6 mile Northeast of State Highway 87, Southeast and East a distance of approximately 1.0 mile, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Sabine County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.
2. Sabine County will provide for the adjustment of utilities, the construction of continuous curb and gutter, curb inlets, storm sewers, etc., all as may be necessary for a complete project with the exception of pavement and its support.

At such time as the County shall accept the provisions of this Order, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$400, and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an estimated cost of \$191,500, as authorized in the 1983-1984 Texas Farm to Market Road Program, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.

In SABINE COUNTY a FARM TO MARKET ROAD is hereby designated extending from State Highway 21, 2.0 miles West of Geneva, North a distance of approximately 1.8 miles, subject to the condition that Sabine County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.

At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$400, and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an estimated cost of \$310,300, as authorized in the 1983-1984 Texas Farm to Market Road Program, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.
