Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to approve the Quarterly report. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr. to sign the application for the municipal solid waste site in Pct. # 2, Brookeland. Motion Carried. ~~See Attached Exhibit.~~
Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to abandon a portion of the road known as Blue Springs road in Precinct No. 3. Motion Carried, See Exhibit attached to minutes.

Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Jr., seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to accept the deed from Sabine County to Twin Cedars & Holly Bay Property Owners Assoc. All voted in favor of this motion, motion carried. See Attached Exhibit.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr. to accept the list of names submitted to the court for the Sabine County Sesquicentennial Committee. Motion Carried. See Attached.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr. to sign the letter of engagement with the auditing firm of Alexander & Rogers, to audit the tax office from October 1, 1983 to January 31, 1984. Motion Carried.
