Bids were opened for the motor grader for Precinct No. 2. Two bids were presented to the court. A bid of \$63,297.00 was submitted from Hyco Equipment for John Deere. One bid from George Bane in the amount of \$53,500.00. Commissioner McGee stated that the bids be tabled until at which time the County Judge would by present with the court. At this time the Commissioners Court would then accept the bid from George Bane Company. See Exhibit attached to the minutes.
