The meeting was called to order by the County Judge, Royce C. Smith. The bills were examined and made ready for payment. Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay bills. Motion carried.

Leon Adickes met with the court for the approval of a Plat. Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to accept the Plat ADICKES-WINSLOW ADDITION for filing but do not accept the roads for maintenance. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to appoint County Judge Royce C. Smith as Sabine County's member of the Board of Directors for the Deep East Texas Council of Government. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr. seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to purchase a 450 C Track Dozer W/Winch, 1977 John Deere 450CC271580T from General Services Administration in Fort Worth for Commissioner Pct. No. 4. This is to be paid by issuing a Time Warrant in the amount of \$10,031.00. Motion carried. Resolution is marked "Exhibit A" and attached to minutes of this date.

Mrs. Lavonne Pate met with the court requesting waiver of in Lieu of taxes payments including any due or passed due and an

additional 2 year period. The request is results of both Housing Authority applying for federal funds for remodeling. Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to allow this to be waived. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Billy Joe McGee to pay Attorney Edwin York, Jr. the amount of \$4,014.94 for Delinquent Taxes collected for the months of October 1983 through April 1984. Motion carried.


RESOLUTION

On this the 25th day of June, 1984, a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas was held at 8:30 o'clock A. M. Among other business, the following resolution was presented:

That Sabine County, Texas borrow the sum of \$10,031.00 from First State Bank, Hemphill, Texas for the purchase price of a 450 C Track Dozer w/Winch, 1977 John Deere 450CC271580T from General Services Administration in Fort Worth for Commissioner Precinct No. 4.
