The meeting was called to order by the County Judge. The monthly bills were examined and made ready for payment and turned in for payment.

Wally Kittman and Blanche Toole met with the court concerning the Sabine County Sesquicentennial Committee project. Upon a motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith and with all voting in favor the following Resolution.

#### RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sabine County Commissioners' Court adopt the logo "SABINE COUNTY BIRTHPLACE OF TEXAS" as the official logo for Sabine County. This logo being based on the fact that Stephen F. Austin "The Father of Texas" first set foot in Texas on July 16, 1821 in what is now Sabine County. Reference page 3 of Historical Sketch of Sabine County.

That the Resolution be sent to the State Legislature and that the logo "SABINE COUNTY BIRTHPLACE OF TEXAS" be adopted as the Official Logo for the Texas Sesquicentennial and future slogan for Sabine County. This claim being based on the same fact as recorded in the "Historical Sketch of Sabine County.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to appoint the following Election Judges at the following Polling Places. See attached list marked "Exhibit A" Also this motion included paying Election Judges \$50.00 per day and Clerks \$30.00 per day for working the election. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison that each election judge use the minimum amount of workers as needed for holding the election and that each Judge and Clerk attending the Election School held by the Secretary of State Office on October 18th be paid \$15.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to pay monthly bills. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to amend the 1983-84 Revenue Sharing Budget in the amount of \$3,198.00. Motion carried.

On discussing the Budget for 1984-85 Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to add a 5% raise across the board on salaries only effective January 1, 1985, and then to approve the Budget for 1984-85. Motion carried. Tax Appraisal District expense per month will be \$1,936.00.

In previous year 18% of the Advalorem Tax went into Road & Bridge. Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to reduce the R. & B. percentage to 15% and add this extra 3% to Bond for Jail Fund. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to pay off the time warrant for R. & B. #4 in the amount of \$6800.00 plus interest on motor grader. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.
