The court reviewed the current bills and made them ready for payment. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay bills. Motion carried.

Mr. William Herkenratt and other concerned citizens appeared before the court and presented a petition in reference to the West County Line Road in Commissioner Precinct No. 2. Said road also extends into San Augustine County. Petitioners are asking the Court to approve for construction a Farm to Market road to replace this road. Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to accept the petition and that a copy be forwarded to proper channel which is District Office in Lufkin and also that it be presented to San Augustine County Commissioners Court. Diane Husband, Tax Assessor - Collector met with the court and gave her report of Fees of office. The other officers reports were reviewed and approved.

Carl Foster met with the court concerning the road that had been constructed from the Lee Smith further on pass the Williard Byrd place. Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to accept this part of the Lee Smith road on down to the end as a county road, the portion down to the Lee Smith place had already been a county road. Motion carried.

Bids were called for as advertised for Loader-Backhoe for Commissioner Precinct No. 2 and Commissioner Precinct No. 4. There was one bid given and it was from Bennett Equipment Company, Longview, Texas. Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr. not to accept this bid. Motion carried.

Elizabeth Brice, County Attorney Pro-Tem met with the Court to discuss the Cable TV contract with Star Cable Company. County Judge recommended that the court get this cleared up. Mrs. Brice suggested that Star Cable be contacted and seek a very described area that they are interested in or if they are willing to give up their franchise. Motion by Commissioner Chester D. Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee that this be done. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the court adjourned.

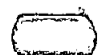
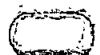

We, the undersigned property owners of Precinct 2 of Sabine County and Precinct of San Augustine respectfully petition the commissioners courts to approve for construction a farm to market road to replace the current unimproved county road described below. The location, distance, and persons served are as follows:

This road crosses the county line between the two counties several times, and is maintained by both counties. It begins at the point that FM Road 2866 meets highway 83. From the beginning it goes southward approximately 5 miles crossing the county line several times, then it turns east approximately .9 mile on the county line. At that point it forks. The right fork goes toward Needmore Point, 2 miles. The left fork goes approximately .3 of a mile to Lake Sam Rayburn Estates. This road serves approximately 80 land owners, 40 residents and 8 or more school children. We anticipate these numbers will increase by 15% within the next 5 years.
