RESOLUTIONS

WHEREAS: The southern pine beetle is one of the most destructive forest pests in East Texas, and

WHEREAS: Epidemic infestations can cross property boundaries and cause economic losses on adjoining properties, and

WHEREAS: The U.S. Forest Service has a responsibility to protect National Forest, including wilderness, values from unwarranted loss, and

WHEREAS: The U. S. Forest Service also has a responsibility to protect adjacent property owners from losses caused by events originating on National Forest lands, and

WHEREAS: Direct control is the only known effective means for minimizing losses caused by epidemic infestations of the southern pine beetle, and

WHEREAS: the complexity of the forest requires the judgement and expertise of professional resource managers to maintain a healthy forest,

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Sabine Co. Comm. Court hereby endorses the professional efforts of the U.S. Forest Service to control outbreaks of the southern pine beetle on the National Forests of Texas, including designated wilderness areas, and affirms the importance of scientific and professional management of all forest resources.
