Commissioner Billy Joe McGee made a motion, with Commissioner R. E. Smith seconding, to approve payment of bills and salaries. Motion carried.

Mrs. Jessie Bird approached Commissioner R. E. Smith about oil work done on her county maintained road, and wanted to know why he hadn't oiled all of that county road, as there was only a short distance left unoiled. Mrs. Bird requested the County to buy the oil needed to finish the road, and her husband would spread the oil himself. Commission Smith said "no", he would not give them the oil, nor would he oil that part of the road himself this year.

John Morgan requested Court to remove cattleguard going to his property, that has resently been installed. Commissioners ask County Attorney, Elizabeth Brice, to check with the State concerning this.

Bids were opened from Loveladdy Oil Co., Center, Texas; and Terrill Pet. Co., Inc. on prices of oil. (See attached exhibits) Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion to stay with Terrill Pet. Co., Inc. Commissioner Eldridge Ellison seconded. Motion carried.

Forrest Perkins appeared before the court, from Sam Rayburn Estates, asking to be allowed to form a Utility Company. County Attorney, Pro-Term, Elizabeth Brice was ask to check into this matter and see if it is legal.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion to divide lateral road monies four ways. Motion carried.
