court with signatures of the people at El Camino for building a
road described as follows: The proposed road is approximately

Camino Road. The road is about two miles in length, at the end

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pay off the Time Warrant on General County Fund in the amount of \$50,000.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner R.E.Smith to pay off Time Warrant for Loader on Commissioner Pct. No. 3. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to pay interest on Time Warrant for Mack Truck on Commissioner Precinct No. 2 and re-new., seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison and the following Resolution was passed by the court. Marked "Exhibit A"and attached to minutes of this date.

Motion by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to divide the Forest Service Interest money in the usual manner. Motion carried.

Cox, Sr., seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to stipulate in the Commissioners Court Record that there is now a county road going across Dr. Rutledge property Partial 16, that will be returned to land owner when Farm road is completed and declared so by state. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee to advertise for bids on new Motor Grader with trade-in of 710 Champion Motor Grader. Bids to be opened February 24th at 9:00 A.M. Motion carried.

The court was notified that there was \$1000.00 remaining in the Planning Grant Fund, and needed to be returned to State.
