

The Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session Monday, October 13, 1986 at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Smith.

Monthly bills were inspected, and made ready for payment. Commissioner Billy J. McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to approve payment of bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report, Tax Collector, and County and District Clerk's reports were presented. Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to approve reports. Motion carried.

Commissioner Billy McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to approve the appointment of Brother Clarence Howell as Absentee Election Judge. Motion carried. Commissioner Billy McGee made motion to pay the clerks holding the General Election \$4.00 per hour, and the Judges \$4.00 per hour, plus an extra \$15.00 for picking up and delivering supplies. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison; motion carried.

After Commissioners' Court reviewed the prices submitted by Smith's T.V., (\$1157.00 for a 60 watt amplifier,) and Hammock's T.V., (1595.00 for a 100 watt amplifier,) and considering the size of the District Court room, and the possibility of adding additional channels at a later date, the Court agreed on Hammock's price. Smith's T.V. reported they could not get the 100 watt amplifier. Commissioner Billy McGee made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to accept Hammock's bid. Motion carried.

There were no bids submitted on the Courthouse roof repair.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee to transfer the \$15,000.00 Grant from Temple Foundation to Sabine County Historical Commission. All voted for.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to split the \$9,822.00 Federal Land Management check five ways the same as in the past. Motion carried.

Thomas Hamilton met with the Court concerning legal marking of County vehicles. All Commissioners informed him they had ordered signs for the sides of their vehicles and equipment, and would place those signs in the location required by law as soon as they received delivery of them.

It was called to the attention of Commissioner Prct. # 1 that a sign was

needed on a dead-end road in Lowes Creek. Commissioner Smith answered that there had been a sign there at one time. Someone must have taken it down, but he would replace it.

Commissioner Billy McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison that meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
