On Monday, February 23, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:00 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Smith. Opening Prayer was led by Brother Clarence Howell.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Nadine Gary, County Clerk. Commissioner Cox made motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Richard Drake with the lst Judicial District Probation Department met with the Court with a request for financial assistance from Sabine County for Juveniles taken to Beaumont. He reported that 25 youths, age 16 and under were taken to Beaumont from the Sabine County area last year. Mr. Drake asked that Sabine County allocate $\$ 2,188.00$ in our budget for 1988 to help with this expense. Commissioner Billy Joe McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to include this in the budget for 1988. Motion carried.

Commissioner R. E. Smith mademotion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to elect Commissioner Billy Joe McGee as County Judge Pro-Tem to preside in absence of Judge Smith. All voted for.

Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison to divide the U. S. Forest check which totaled $\$ 3,403.24$, as follows: County Schools: $\$ 1,701.62$, Officer's Salary: $\$ 85.08$, to divide among Commissioners: $\$ 1,616.54$. All voted for. See Exhibit attached.

The Sabine County Commissioners Court selected the Salary Grievance Committee according to Art. 3912K. Members selected from the Grand Jury were: Weldon Thomas, Rt. 1, Bronson, Texas; Jerry A. McBride, P. 0. Box 128, Bronson, Texas; James Rickey Arney, P. 0. Box 915, Hemphill, Texas, along with the County Judge, Sheriff, Tax Assessor-Collector, Treasurer, and County Clexk, and County Attorney. Motion was made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve this committee. Motion carried.

A petition from the property owners and voters of Precinct 2, was submitted to the Court to approve the construction of a Farm to Market Road to replace approximately 2.9 miles of unimproved county maintained road known as Pleasure Bend Road. It is currently a U. S. Mail route and a school bus route. Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith to accept this petition. All voted for. After certification of the names, a'copy will be sent to the Lufkin

District Office, and a copy to the State.
Landowners in Precinct 4 presented the Court with a petition to close the road that led from Farm Road 2784 to the P. H. McGown house place. All of the road is on P. H. McGown property. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Motion carried. Commissioner Ellison to accept this petition// The County Clerk will certify these names, and post the petition on the bulletin board 20 days. This will be an agenda item for Commissioners' Court Monday, March 23, 1987. At this time the Court will either accept or reject the closing of this road in Precinct 4.

Bids which were advertised in the paper were opened at $8 ; 30$. There were two bids for a 2 Ton Truck for Pret. 3: one from Hemphill Motor Company for $\$ 18,242.78$, and one from Roper Motor Company in San Augustine for $\$ 18,925.00$. Commissioner Ellison made motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith to accept Hemphill Motor Company's bid. Motion carried.

There were two bids submitted for a Track Loader for Pret. 2. One was from Harrell Machinery, Inc. for $\$ 31,350.00$; this was for a John Deere Loader. George P. Bane, Inc. gave a' bid of $\$ 53,400.00$ for a Fiatallis FL7 Crawler Loader. Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith to accept the bid from Harrell Machinery, Inc. Motion carried.

Judge Smith presented the Court with a bill for $\$ 13,760.25$ from Jay Tex Construction for repairs to the Court House roof. He said they agreed to do more yard work when it is dryer. The roof did not leak during the last rain before this meeting, but it was agreed not to pay the bill until the next meeting:

Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, to pay off Prot. \# I Time Warrant in the amount of $\$ 20,000.00$ plus interest. Motion carried. Also, Commissioner Chester Cox made motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, to pay off Pret. \# 4 Time Warrant in the amount of $\$ 19,900.00$ plus interest. Motion carried.

Judge Smith presented a letter from Attorney John Scale concerning the dismissal of Marsha Williams, and the charges filed against her. Commissioner Billy Joe McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox to mule on this in an Executive session when our County Attorney is present, and after he has had a chance to review this action. Motion carried.

Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox to approve payment of accounts and salaries. All voted for.

Commissioner Cox made motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison that meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
