Om Monday, March 9, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners Court met in a Regular session with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith; with Brother Clarence Howell leading the opening prayer.

Nadine Gary, County Clerk, read the minutes of the previous meetings; this included two called meetings, and one regular meeting. Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to approve reading of minutes. All voted for.

Monthly bills were reviewed and made ready for payment. Commissioner Billy McGee made motion to approve payment, with Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded. Motion carried.

After discussing payment to Jatex Construction, Inc.for repairs to Courthouse roof, the Court decided to withhold 10% of payment until yard work is completed. The total bill for this repair was \$13,760.25, so we will pay \$12,384.23 now, and hold \$1376.02 until yard work is satisfactory. Commissioner Billy McGee made motion that after checking records for bid price, we pay the 90%; Commissioner R. E. Smith seconded. All voted for.

The following written reports were presented for inspection: Treasurer's Report, County Clerk's report, District Clerk's report, Tax Collector's report. Also reports from J.P. # 1, Frank Rash, J.P. # 2, Wilbert Bragg, J.P. # 3, Albert Welch, and J.P. # 4, Bobby White. Commissioner Chester Cox made motion, seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee to approve reports. Motion carried.

Mr. Joe Williams, a resident of Scrapping Valley in Prct. 2, met with the Court concerning repairs for his road. He asked Commissioner McGee for surface material on his road, instead of grading after every rain. Commissioner McGee answered that in the past year he had spent \$600.00 for two culverts for the one mile leading to his home, and he would grant hissrequest of not grading. He also stated that he would do repairs to his road whenever possible.

Concerned citizens from Pineland, and West Sabine and Hemphill I.S.D.

met with the Court about the proposal for licensing of an Emotional Treatment

Center by Elzie Wright Ministries, Inc. to be located in Pineland, Texas.

Jackie Hilton, Supertendent at West Sabine School voiced his opposition to

this Home. He stated it was to house as many as 25 boys, and their school is

already crowded, and no money is provided for this type of thing. They added two classroom for this year at a cost of \$50,000.00. The headquarters for this Youth Council is Orange, Texas. A discussion from the floor followed.

Motion was made by Commissioner Billy J. McGee, seconded by Commissioner

R. E. Smith, that Court pass a resolution opposing the licensing of an Emotional

Treatment Center by Elzie Wright Ministries, Inc. located in Pineland, Texas,
to house emotionally disturbed juveniles. Motion carried.

Commissioner Billy J. McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, that before any type of licensed residential facilities is allowed to operate in Sabine County, it must come before the Commissioners' Court for approval. Motion carried.

Although Robert and Vicky Lemoine were on the agenda concerning their roads in Prct. # 2, they did not appear. Commissioner McGee said he had talked with them about this.

Mr. Claude Vickers met with the Court with questions concerning the County. He asked why everything was not put in the paper, and why the Sabine County Reporter is the only paper represented at Commissioners' Court. He also asked why Sabine County is audited every three years instead of every year. The auditors are in the process of auditing 1985 and 1986 at the present time. Another question was: where does the money go? The County Clerk's office and the Treasurer's office write and sign the checks, and bills are kept in the Clerk's office. The Treasurer has the register of checks, and these records are open to the public at any time.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to advertise for bids for County Hospital Group Insurance. The bidder must show proof from the State Board of Insurance of being licensed by the State of Texas. Bids will be opened at the Regular meeting April 13, 1987.

The Court drew the name of Donald Ray Wood, Box 58, Brookeland, Texas to replace Weldon Thomas, Rt. 1, Bronson, to serve on the Grievance Committee, because Mr. Thomas was unable to serve.

Judge Smith informed the Court that the hearing for West County Line Road in Sam Rayburn Estates, which was set in Austin March 31 has been changed to May 27, 1987. It will be first on the agenda at that date. Some of the residents have already been notified.

Judge Smith presented a letter from Sabine Investment concerning roads in Pleasure Bend Subdivision. They are contemplating making the internal roads a private 40' wide road with gravel topping and selling the tracts to the center-line of the road with a maintenance fund implemented so that each property owner will maintain this road as needed. The question is does the County have any restrictions against selling to the centerline of the road? Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to accept this proposal.

Motion carried.

We received the following bids for repair for interior of Court House: Robert White: \$15.00 per hour, plus \$6.00 for helper. Toby Gomez, \$9.50 per hour, plus \$7.00 per hour for helper, Dave Brown, \$13.00 per hour, no helper. Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison to accept Toby Gomez's bid. All voted for.

Commissioner Billy McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to pass a resolution for a Time Warrant for \$31,350.00 from First - State Bank to purchase a John Deere 555B Tract Loader for Prct. # 2. Motion carried.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made motion, seconded by Commissioner Billy J. McGee, to advertise for bids to sell a 1974 model Ford Truck. Bids will be opened at the Regular meeting March 23, 1987. Motion carried.

Commissioner Chester Cox made a motion to accept the Consent and Agreement between property owners and County to improve that section of County Road, which improvement consists of improving drainage and widening as needed. This road is described as Cordray Lane Road, Precinct No. 4. Motion carried. See attached Exhibit.

Commissioner Chester Cox made motion, seconded by Commissioner Billy J. McGee, to re-accept Ridge Rock Road into Piney Point Subdivision as a County maintained road. Motion carried.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, that meeting adjourn. All voted for.


