

On Monday, June 22, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Smith, and prayer was led by Brother Clarence Howell.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by the Clerk, Nadine Gary. Motion was made by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to approve the minutes. All voted for.

County bills were inspected and made ready for payment. Motion was made by Commissioner Billy Joe McGee, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, to approve payment. Motion carried.

Sabine County Historical Commission Officers and Members for 1987 were approved by the Court. Motion was made by Commissioner McGee, seconded by Commissioner Cox to approve the submitted list. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Since July 4th, which is a regular County Holiday, falls on Saturday, the Court agreed to observe Friday, July 3rd, so the Court House will be closed on this day. This motion was made by Commissioner McGee, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, and all voted for.

Roy Chance, a resident of the road known as the ^{Murray} Chance Road, off Hwy. 87 South, met with the Court again concerning the posting of a speed limit sign on his road. After some discussion, Commissioner R. E. Smith promised to order and post a 20 Mile per hour speed limit sign on his road. Commissioner McGee made motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison to post this sign just off Hwy. 87. Motion carried.

T. K. Stephenson submitted a plat to Kennawood Estates Subdivision for the Courts approval. Commissioner Billy McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to approve this plat. Motion carried.

Claude Vickers met with the Court concerning the posting of the agenda for Commissioners Court. As was previously stated in the minutes dated December 22, 1986, the agenda is posted at 11:00 A. M. on Thursday before the meeting the following Monday. Anyone wishing to be on the agenda should contact the County Clerk's office before this date and time.

After discussion the Court agreed to call an election August 8 to determine if the County Sales and Use Tax under H.B. 79 will be held in the County. This concerns the adoption of a one-half percent tax within the County to be used to reduce the property tax rate. Upon a motion by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, the motion carried.

Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee to appoint Election Judges for 1987-1988. All voted for. The following judges were approved:

Judge Smith called a 10 minute recess before going into the Budget Session for 1987-1988. Court re-convened at 9:30 A. M.

Judge Smith explained to the Court that there were still balances due on some pledges which were made in the 1986-1987 Budget. He asked the Court for authority to pay these balances. Commissioner Chester Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison to give this permission. Motion carried. The payments still due and approved are:

There will be more work on the Budget at the next regular meeting which will be Monday, July 13, 1987.


Plans are being made for a Court House Open House Wednesday, July 15.

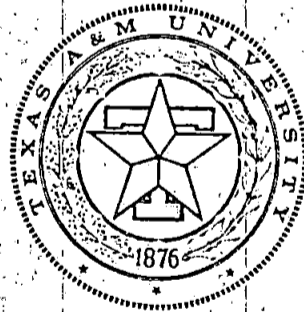

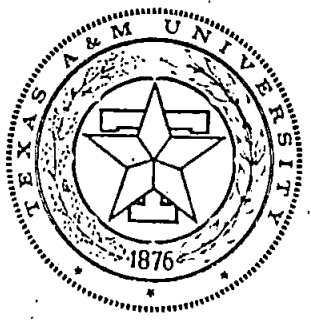
