

Monday, August 10, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners Court met in a regular session with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith, with Judge Smith also leading the opening prayer.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, the minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. All voted for.

County bills were inspected and made ready for payment. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith to approve payment of bills. Motion carried.

The following reports were presented for approval: Treasurer's report, J. P., Prct. # 1, J. P., Prct. # 2, J. P., Prct. # 5, also the County Clerk and District Clerk's reports. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Ellison to approve the reports. Motion carried.

Although Dough Damron was on the agenda again this week concerning mail delivery Rebel Ridge Subdivision, he did not appear. Commissioner Smith informed the Court that to change the restrictions for a subdivision, it must have the approval of all the residents.

Commissioner Cox presented a plat showing a Road Easement known as Lazy J Marina Road. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to accept the plat. Motion carried.

Commissioner Ellison made motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve the Quarterly Report. All voted in favor.

Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to advertise for bids to sell D. D.. Allis Chalmers Maintainer; to sell as is. The Court reserves the right to reject any bids. Bid opening will be at the regular meeting, August 24, 1987, at 9:00 A. M.

Three bids were received for the front-end loader advertised for for Prct. # 1. They were from Bennett Equipment, George Banes, Inc., and Harrell Machinery. (Bids Attached) All bids were rejected at this time. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to accept the bid from George Banes, Inc. Commissioner McGee and Commissioner Cox voted against this motion. Judge Smith broke the tie by voting with Commissioner McGee and Commissioner Cox.

With a motion made by Commissioner Ellison, seconded by Commissioner McGee, and all voting in favor, the Court passed a resolution declaring the Tax Election official. See attached Exhibit.

Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to pay \$ 16,000.00 plus interest on a Time Warrant for Prct. # 4 in the amount of \$ 55,000.00, dated August 4, 1986. Motion carried. This Warrant was for a 1986 Mack Dump Truck.

Commissioner McGee made a motion to pay off Prct. #2 Time Warrant in the amount of \$28,189.31 plus interest. \$ 26,244.14 will be paid out of Revenue Sharing, with \$ 1,945.17 plus the interest being paid out of Right of Way. This Time Warrant is for Matching funds paid to the State of Texas for Sabine County's part of construction of State approved concrete and steel bridge on Six Mile Creek in Prct. # 2. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Cox, and all voted for.

The sanitary land fill for Brookeland was discussed. This land fill will be located on the East side of Hwy. 96, south of the Air Port Road, between Pineland and Brookeland. Commissioner McGee informed the Court it will cost approximately \$ 17,000.00 to get this site ready, and said Attorney Fortson is checking to see if a tax can be added to meet this expense.

Walter Diggles with D. E. C. O. G. met with the Court concerning the audit payment on the Old San Antonio Road. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to ask the State to pay the audit of \$ 2,000.00; the check will be sent to the Sabine county Treasurer. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to go into Executive Session. Motion carried.

In the Executive Session, personal, purchase of equipment, and payment of overtime was discussed.

Regular session re-convened at 10:50 A. M.

Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, that the current level of County employees be frozen at the now level. Also, before hiring any temporary employee to work over 10 days, the department head must meet with the Court and have prior justification, and get approval by the Court. All voted in favor.



R E S O L U T I O N

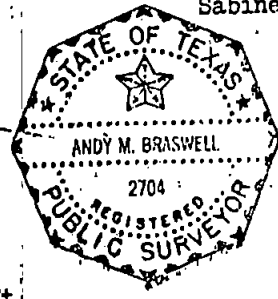


On August 10, 1987, a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas was held at 8:30 A. M. Among other business, the following resolution was presented:
