

Monday, October 26, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30, A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Smith, with Brother Clarence Howell leading the opening prayer.

Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve the reading of the minutes of the last meeting. All voted for.

Commissioner Cox informed the Court that instead of a one mile spur of the Mable Henson cut-off leading to the Black cemetery in Precinct 4, it is 0.9 of a mile. This was accepted as a County Road at the last meeting.

Commissioner R. E. Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee, to approve payment of bills. All voted for.

County Treasurer, Ollie Faye Sparks, presented the annual report for the year 10/1/86 thru 9/31/87.

Judge Smith also informed the Court that ^{the} County and District Clerks turned in the monies that has been in their accounts several years. County Clerk, Nadine Gary, turned in \$ 13,017.27, while District Clerk, Tanya Walker, turned in \$ 33,952.83; making a total of \$ 46,970.10. The Commissioners Court agreed that any future claims made by authorized recipients with proper proof, against these monies transferred will be honored by the County. This money will be paid out of the General Fund. Motion was made by Commissioner R. E. Smith, seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee, to accept this agreement. All voted for.


Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to use \$2,750.00 of the transferred money to purchase a copy machine for the District Clerk and second floor. Motion carried. Other division of this money is as follows:

Roof repair on jail	\$1,500.00
Jury Fund	17,700.00


The remaining money will be divided equally between the four precincts. This motion was made by Commissioner McGee, and seconded by Commissioner Smith. Motion carried.

Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, that the County advertise for bids for a 10 gauge metal culvert, 12 feet in diameter, 30 feet long. Bids will be opened at our next meeting, November 9. Motion carried.


There being no further business, Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, meeting adjourn. All voted for.
