Monday, September 14, 1987, the Honorable Commissioners Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order By Judge Royce Smith. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meetings were read and approved. There were two called meetings, and one regular meeting. Commissioner Eldridge Ellison made a motion, seconded by Commissioner R. E. Smith, to approve the minutes of the first called meeting. Motion carried. Commissioner Smith made a motion seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve the reading of the minutes for the regular meeting. All voted in favor. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve the minutes for the second called meeting. All voted for.

Monthly bills were inspected, and made ready for payment. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to approve payment of bills. All voted in favor.

Various County reports were presented for inspection. See "Exhibit" attached. Tax Collector, Diane Husband reported that 93% of the taxes for 1986 had been collected. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve these reports. All voted for.

Although Ray Meleton with Temple was on the agenda concerning a road in Prct. 4, he did not appear. Commissioner Cox asked that this be deleted until a later date.

The Court set new fees to be charged by the offices of the Sheriff and Constables for service or attemped service of Civil preceedings, to be effective January 1, 1988. These new fees will be \$40.00 each. Motion was made by Commissioner McGee and seconded by Commissioner Ellison to approve these fees. All voted for.

Tax Collector Diane Husband and County Clerk, Nadine Gary, made a proposal to the Court to begin collecting \$25.00 service charge on insufficient checks written to their offices. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to apporove this proposal. Motion carried.

Commissioner Cox asked that Doyle Herndon's name be deleted from the agenda until a later date.

Mrs. Genevia Hignite and other citizens from Sam Rayburn Estates, again met With the Court concerning their roads. They said they are in terrible condition now. The State has informed the residents that although theirs was a top priority road, they can do nothing on it at this time. Therefore they are again asking the Commissioners for assistance. Commissioner Billy McGee answered that Commissioner Eldridge Ellison has offered to take over the Sam Rayburn Estates road; but he would also help whenever possible.

Judge Smith reported the new jail roof needs a coat of material added at least every three years, and there are some leaks now. He also stated Mr. Reynolds has presented an estimate of \$1,500.00 for maintance and repairs. Motion was made by Commissioner Ellison, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to advertise for bids for roof repairs on the new jail. All voted for. Bids

will be opened at our regular meeting September 28, at 9:00 Å. M.

Commissioner McGee brought it to the Court's attention that utility companies are destroying the County Right of ways when installing new lines. Commissioner McGee then made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, that before any utility Company can install any type of utility line in County right of way, they must have written consent from the Commissioners Court. All voted in favor.

There was some discussion concerning the State/Federal off System Bridges. In this program, the State pays 80% of the Cost, and the County is responsible for 20%. A list of three bridges was presented for consideration when funds are available. No action was taken at this time. See "Exhibit".

There was a discussion concerning the scar fire controversy between Sabine County, Prct. 2, and George Banes, Inc. Commissioner McGee stated that a new scar fire will cost \$4,475.00, and George Banes agreed to let him have one for \$1,350.00. We can pay for this in three (3) equal monthly payments, with no interest. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to purchase this scar fire. 3 voted for, while Commissioner Cox abstained. Motion carried.

There were four bids received on the loader advertised for Prct. # 1 to buy. These received were from: George Banes, Inc., Bennett Equipment Co., Harrell Machinery, Inc., and Mustang Tractor and Equipment. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to accept George Banes' bid of \$39,832.00. Three voted for, while Commissioner Cox abstained. Motion carried.

Commissioner Cox brought it to the courts' attention that although the audit for 1984 has been paid for, it was given to the Grand Jury, and we have not seen the report. He said he thought the Court should get the report. Commissioner McGee pointed out that the case has not been desposed of.

Commissioner Cox also discussed the possibility of buying a recorder to be used in Commissioners' Court meetings. The Court gave the Clerk the authority to purchase one.

The Judge presented the Court with a letter from Chief Appraiser, Jim Nethery, informing the Court it is time to select the members of the Sabine County Appraisal District who will serve from January 1, 1988 thru December 31, 1989. See "Exhibit" - Copy of letter and Resolution. No action was taken at this time.

There being no further business, Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, that meeting adjourn. All voted for.

House Bill 268

AN ACT

relating to the persons eligible to serve on the board of directors of an appraisal district.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. Section 6.03(a). Tax Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) The appraisal district is governed by a board of five directors. To be eligible to serve on the board of directors, an individual must be a resident of the district and must have resided in the district for at loast two years immediately preceding the date he takes the office. An individual who is otherwise eligible to serve on the board is not ineligible because of membership on the governing body of a taxing unit or because the individual is an elected official. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

WHEREAS, the Texas Property Tax Code provides for changing the selection method by a 3/4 (three quarter) vote of the taxing units in the district,

THEREFORE be it resolved that future Sabine County Appraisal District Director's be selected as follows:

- 1) Using the distribution of votes made under the present system, each taxing unit will appoint one (1) director for each 1,000 or portion of 1,000 votes.
- 2) Selection will be made by the governing board or council in November of odd years.
- 3) Director's will take office January 1st of even years to serve for two (2) years, and
- 4) Removal of or replacement of a director will be made by the governing body who elected the director.

Motion being properly made and seconded, this RESOLUTION was adopted by the undersigned on Thursday, May 28, 1987.


