

Monday, April 11, 1988, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce C. Smith. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve minutes. All voted for.

Monthly bills were inspected and made ready for payment. Commissioner Cox questioned a bill from Dr. G. C. Winslow for treatment of several jail employees. After contacting Sheriff Greer, we were told this was for T B shots, since they had a prisoner with infectious T. B. After this discussion, Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve payment. Motion carried.

The following monthly reports were presented for inspection: County Treasurer, Tax Assessor-Collector, County Clerk, District Clerk, and J. P. reports. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve reports. Motion carried.

Judge Smith presented the court with a certificate from Southwest Texas State University Texas Justice Court Training Center for Herbert W. Bragg, showing his completion of a twenty hour course in the duties of Justice of the Peace as required by Article 27.005 - Texas Government Code. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, that this be entered into the minutes as a matter of record. Motion carried.

Judge Smith also presented his certificate from Texas College of Probate Judges certifying his completion of the continuing Judicial education program at Houston, Texas October 24, 1987. Commissioner R. E. Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Eldridge Ellison, that this be entered into the minutes as a matter of record. Motion carried.

Burton Lakey again met with the Court concerning the closing of a road on his property in Prct. # 2. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, that after proper posting, this road will be considered closed. Motion carried.

Although Dian Husband was on the agenda concerning the cost of a Tax Certificate, nothing was done on this at this time.

Judge Smith presented the Court with a Resolution concerning the opposition of increasing the size of the Big Thicket along Village Creek in Hardin County. Hardin County Commissioners are opposed to this. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, that we accept this resolution. All voted for.

Lynn Smith, a resident of Sabine County, met with the Court concerning the misuse of the Tax Payer's money. Mr. Smith said he was speaking in his own behalf, and did not represent any organization. He also stated he wanted to go ^{on} record as being opposed to County money being spent to pay for liquor on County trips, and also opposing the Court for letting it happen; and paying expenses for friends and family. Mr. Smith also asked the Court to

consider passing a motion that each trip be approved in advance, or there will be no reimbursement. Commissioner Billy McGee explained that he and the other three Commissioners have spent less than their budget over the past five years, and have brought back approximately \$2,000,000.00 for County use. Commissioner Chester Cox said maybe, at a later date, the Court should pass a resolution stating each trip shall be approved in advance. Discussion from the floor followed in which residents said the Commissioners should explain their trips, and the bookkeeping should be better detailed concerning them.

Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to postpone the opening of Insurance Bids until our next meeting, April 25. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, that meeting adjourn. Motion carried.





PRESENTED TO COMMISSIONER'S COURT ON April 11, 1988

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, House Bill 3544 has been introduced in the 100th Congress, 1st. Session, to increase the size of the Big Thicket National Preserve in the State of Texas by adding the Village Creek Corridor, the Big Sandy Corridor and the Canyonlands Unit; and,

WHEREAS, 86,000 acres of land has already been set aside and made into a national park in the Big Thicket; and,

WHEREAS, House Bill 3544 would add an additional 14,000 acres to the Preserve thereby removing an additional 14,000 acres of land from the tax roll of the counties involved; and

WHEREAS, in the eighteenth century, private land ownership came about with the understanding that the rivers and streams of Texas belong to all the people; and,

WHEREAS, this Commissioners' Court believes in the principle of private properties, individual rights and liberty as guaranteed by our U. S. Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, this Commissioners' Court believes in the principle of the protection of the rights of minorities, be it property owners, religious zealots and/or races of people, and do not believe that homes, ranches, and farms should be taken from their rightful owners; and,

WHEREAS, some legislators in Congress, led by Texas' Phil Gramm, are mandating more fiscal responsibility in Government; and,

WHEREAS, Texas' dependence on oil production and it's current decline, have forced more bankruptcies over the past few months than at any time since Texas became a state; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County believes that 1987-88 is not the time for the government to be buying lands; and,

WHEREAS, the people of Sabine County have always insisted on fair play and believe that HB 3544, as written, is not fair to all the parties involved; and,

WHEREAS, this Commissioners Court feels that the polices of management of the original 86,000 acres of the Preserve have been detrimental to adjoining land owners by the lack of control of the Pine Beetle and poor land, soil, and water practices; and,

WHEREAS, Congressman Charles Wilson fought the inclusion of the Village Creek Corridor when the original Preserve was created and this Court has problems with his decision to sponsor the inclusion at this time in light of previous statements that "I feel that 84,000 acres is more than enough land to set aside for nothing more that a pristine wilderness"; and,

WHEREAS, Congressman Wilson has always displayed a keen desire to act in accordance with the wishes of the majority of the people in his district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County goes on record urging Congressman Wilson to fully explore other ways for protecting Village Creek, Big Sandy Creek, and the Canyonlands and at the same time preserving individual rights; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County goes on record encouraging all citizens of Sabine County who believe that HB 3544, as written, does not reflect the wishes of the majority of the people and that, as written, does not display a full sense of fairness to all the parties involved, to convey these feelings to Congressman Wilson in Washington, Room 2265 Sam Rayburn House Office Bldg., Washington, D.C. 20515, phone #202-225-2401; or in Lufkin, at the Homer Garrison Federal Building, 701 North First, Room 201 Lufkin, Texas 75901, phone # 409-637-2770.
