Monday, May 23, 1988, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Due to the absence of County Judge Royce Smith, who was attending the National Meeting of Council of Government as a Representative of Deep East Texas, Commissioner Billy McGee served as Acting Judge Pro-tem.

Meeting was called to order by Commissioner McGee. Opening prayer was led by Brother Clarence Howell.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by County Clerk, Nadine Gary. Commissioner R. E. Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, to approve minutes. Motion carried.

After the inspection of County bills, Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve payment. All voted in favor.

At our last meeting, Commissioner Cox asked the Court to accept roads in Alpine Resort Subdivision as county maintained roads. Commissioner Smith asked to inspect these roads before accepting them, and promised to do this before today's meeting. He reported there were bad places in the roads that must be brought up to standards before they can be accepted.

A. G. Mott, president of Beechwood III & IV Improvement Association, met with the Court concerning roads in Beechwood III & IV in Prct. 2. Also with him were the following members of the Association: Travis Clemmer, Director, C. O. Charles Reese, Treasurer, Mrs. Jerry, "Pat" Wood, Secretary, and Larry Wilkerson, Vice President. They presented a written request concerning the increasing need of street and drainage maintenance in these subdivisions. They had previously discussed this with Commissioner Billy McGee, and he stated he had scheduled Thursday, weather premitting, to start work on these roads. This included oil on the main road.

Tommy Smith was on the agenda and he asked the Court for permission to speak later in the meeting, if he choose. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to grant his request. All voted for.

Mike Strother presented a plat of Spring Hill Estates Subdivision for approval. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve plat for recording only. This does not approve roads in Subdivision. Motion carried.

Commissioner McGee presented a Resolution authorizing the Attorney General of Texas to include Sabine County as a Plaintiff in any suit brought by the Attorney General to collect sales and use taxes which may be owed to this taxing authority. Commissioner Cax made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to accept this resolution. Motion carried. "See attached exhibit."

The Court was presented a bill for \$2,000.00 from Attorney Wesley Hoyt of San Augustine for Professional Services rendered January 1, 1988 thru April 15, 1988, regarding County Criminal Cases in Sabine County. This bill was presented for approval of payment. After some discussion, Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ellison, to approve payment. Motion carried, with two voting for, and one against.

Tommy Smith addressed the Court by discussing payment of this bill. He stressed that he was much against the payment in this manner. He said he was not here to create trouble, but to help, if possible. He also said he agreed there were old cases that should be prosecuted, not at additional expense for the County, but from money already budgeted for this.

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Although Lynn Smith was not on the agenda, the Court allowed him to speak. He said he was no attorney, but had consulted an attorney, and what the Court had done was not legal, and he thought they should know.

Nadine gary, County Clerk, presented certificates from Texas A & M University for the following: Diane Husband, Rhonda Williams, and Nadine Gary. Commissioner Eldridge Ellison made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, to approve these certificates as a matter of record. All voted for.

No bid was received to sell the Sheriff car which was advertised.

Only one bid was received for the cab and frame Prct. 1 had advertised for sell. This was \$ 100.00 from John Sutton. Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, to accept this bid. Motion carried.

Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner \$mith, to advertise for bids to sell a 6-G front-end tract loader for Prct. # 4. Motion carried. This loader can be seen at Milam; contact Chester Cox. Bids to be opened June 13, at 9:00 A.1

Commissioner McGee informed the Court he had a bill from George Banes for \$6,591.41. This was for repairs on his new motor grader. It was left on FM 3315, and someone put dirt in it, doing this amount of damage.

There being no further business, Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, that meeting adjourn. Motion carried.




