Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce C. Smith; Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Deputy Clerk, Janice McDaniel. County Clerk, Nadine Gary, was in College Station attending a siminar for County and District Clerks. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve minutes. Motion carried.

Judge Smith informed the Court that the stock donated to the Virgie Speights Memorial Library has been sold.

Monthly bills were inspected, and Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to pay accounts and salaries. Motion carried.

Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McDaniel, to divide the money received from the Forest Service as per list. Motion carried. See attached exhibit.

Motion was made by Commissioner McGee, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to transfer money from Prct. 1 to Prct. 4 for the purchase of a trailer. Motion carried.

The bid for County Depository received from First State Bank, Hemphill, "Plan B", was discussed by the court with Bob Russell, a representative from the bank. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McDaniel, to accept "Plan B" bid from the First State Bank. Motion carried. See attached exhibits.

The Court discussed the need for a County Barn with a central location. After much discussion, it was decided by the court to check into the cost and to check with Temple about the land and what they are willing to do.

Judge Smith informed the court that the representatives from the Texas Department of Health called to say they couldn't be here for this meeting, but would attend the meeting March 13.







Objectives for 1989-1990 were discussed. No action was taken.



Alternative Bid (A)

1. The Bank will charge a rate of 6% per annum (simple interest) from date on the valid warrants and overdrafts of the county.
2. All funds of the County will be deposited in non-interest bearing accounts at the Bank and drawn on by checks and vouchers from time to time free of service charges.
3. The Bank will charge interest on overdrafts from the date of payment; however, the County will pay such overdrafts with proceeds from warrants or from other sources within three business days from payment of the overdraft.
4. Refunding warrants (renewals) will bear the 6% simple rate from date.

Alternative Bid (B)

1. The Bank will charge an adjustable rate which will always be equal to 2% above the Prime Rate (National Prime) as stated in the Wall Street Journal per annum (simple interest) from date of the valid warrants and overdrafts of the County originating during the ensuing two-year period.
2. All funds of the County will be deposited in "demand deposit" or "time deposit" accounts at the Bank and will earn interest at an adjustable rate which will always be equal to 1% below the Prime Rate (National Prime) as stated in the Wall Street Journal per annum (simple interest) computed on the daily balance and paid monthly. Funds designated as "demand deposits" may be drawn on by checks and vouchers from time to time free of service charges.
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In the event Prime Rate as stated in the Wall Street Journal is quoted as a range, for example 9.75% - 10.00%, the higher rate so stated will be used for all calculation purposes as set out in this alternative bid.

Alternative Bid (C)

1. The Bank will charge a rate of 9% per annum (simple interest) from date on the valid warrants and overdrafts of the County originating during the ensuing two-year period.

2. All funds of the County will be deposited in demand deposit accounts at the Bank and will earn interest at the rate 6% per annum (simple interest) computed on the daily balance and paid monthly. These funds may be drawn on by checks and vouchers from time to time free of service charges.



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
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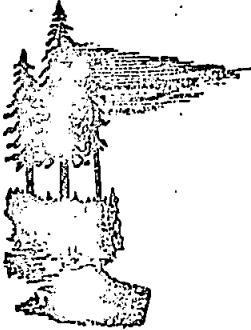

Pineland State Bank would not levy a per item insufficient funds charge if the checking account became overdrawn but would charge interest (same rate as loans) on the overdrawn balance.

Pineland State Bank agrees to provide credit to the county with final maturities not exceeding the expiration date of the depository contract. Interest rate would be determined by the daily quote from the Wall Street Journal Prime Rate and interest on loans be paid, at least, quarterly. The bank would prefer the court provide documentation setting out who is authorized to sign on the demand accounts and loans for the county. Each time thereafter when the necessity arises to borrow funds, that individual(s) would bring a certified copy of the court's minutes and sign a legal loan agreement.

Pineland State Bank further agrees to offer the county any type of savings, time or demand deposit accounts of its choosing at the prevailing interest rate we pay our other customers.
