
Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith, with Brother Clarence Howell leading the opening prayer.


The reason for this called meeting was to again discuss County Health Insurance. Judge Smith informed the court we have a bid from Sunday & Associates in Houston. After some discussion, motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to accept the following proposal with Sunday & Associates. Employee Life and Medical coverage, \$250.00 deductible, cost is: \$154.82. Dependent coverage: Child only - \$84.51
Spouse only 197.25
Family 223.85


Also included in this motion by Commissioner McDaniel was the agreement to pay \$121.00 per month to each employee for dependent coverage of their choice. This is the difference in the previously agreed \$275.00 and \$154.82 per month for employee coverage. All voted for.



Motion was made by Commissioner McGee, seconded by Commissioner Conn, that meeting recess. Motion carried.



Dear Judge Smith,

As we discussed, this is the proposal from Jordan Jones Administrators. The proposal was issued contingent on Mr. Rash not being covered. As stated on page 82 of your current booklet, he can apply for an extension of benefits which would provide coverage for the disabling condition until the earliest of :

1. The day he becomes eligible for benefits;
2. The day the disability ends; or
3. The end of the first 12 months.

A summary of the rates is as follows:


Dear Judge Smith:
