

Monday, September 11, 1989, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith, with Brother Clarence Howell leading the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by County Clerk, Nadine Gary. Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel, and seconded by Commissioner Billy McGee, to approve minutes. Motion carried.

Monthly bills were inspected and made ready for payment. Gene Walker, Court Reporter for Judge J. L. Smith, 273rd District Court, presented a statement for \$6,500.00 for statement of facts in Cause # 5085, The State of Texas vs Tommie L. Davis, and # 5086, The State of Texas vs Faye Logan. After some discussion, Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McDaniel; to approve payment of bills excluding this one for Mr. Walker. Motion carried. Commissioner Cox said he had a bill from George Banes he wanted pulled at this time, too.

Written reports were presented for approval. After the inspection of these reports, Commissioner McGee made the motion they be approved. Commissioner Conn seconded the motion, and all voted for.

On-site sewage facilities was an agenda item. Even tho it was discussed, no action was taken.

Judge Smith informed the Court he had a notice of name change from Western Louisiana Video Co. to ILLINI Cablevision, Inc, a non-exclusive franchise. Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McDaniel, to ratify this name change. Motion carried.

Judge Smith also said he had received notification that the Friendship Cable Television Company of Texas is making plans to offer cable T. V. in Brookeland, an un-incorporated area.

The Tri-County Community Action Board members are meeting tonight, (Monday, Sept. 11) in Pineland, at 6:30. The group asked Judge Smith if the County would pay for the meal at this meeting. There was no cost figure given. Judge Smith answered there was nothing in the budget to cover this, so no action was taken.

Commissioner McGee informed the court the salary fund is in the red. After some discussion, he made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Conn, to transfer \$15,000.00 out of the General fund to Salary to take care of this. Motion carried.

Hillhouse Associates, our former group health carrier, was discussed. Judge Smith is to contact Allison & Associates in Austin and get them to contact Hillhouse about refunding our premium paid in June if they are not going to pay claims for that month.


Bid openings for an independent audit will be Sept. 25, at 9:00 A. M., due to an error in time opening proposals published in paper.

Two bids were received for a heating and cooling system for Judge Smith's




There being no further business, Commissioner McGee made a motion, seconded by Commissioner conn that meeting recess. All voted for.



The COUNTY of SABINE will hold a public hearing to discuss an application to the Texas Department of Commerce in Austin, Texas for funds for a Community Development Grant. Meeting Number Two will be on September 7, 1989, at 5:30 o'clock P.m., in the SABINE COUNTY COURTHOUSE, DISTRICT COURT ROOM

The Texas Community Development Block Grant Program (TCDBG) has established four (4) major objectives for Community Development Programs:

- OBJECTIVE 1: To improve public facilities to meet basic human needs, principally for low and moderate income persons.
- OBJECTIVE 2: To improve housing conditions, principally for persons of low and moderate income.
- OBJECTIVE 3: To expand economic opportunities by creating or retaining jobs, principally for low and moderate income persons.
- OBJECTIVE 4: To provide assistance and public facilities to eliminate conditions hazardous to the public health and of an emergency nature.

This public hearing will include a discussion of the proposed project, the amount of funds being requested, the estimated amount of funds proposed for activities that will benefit low/moderate income persons, and the plans of the locality to minimize displacement of persons and to assist persons actually displaced as a result of activities assisted with TCDP funds, if applicable.

The COUNTY of SABINE has chosen as its project objective to strengthen Community Development through the elimination of conditions which are hazardous to public health and meet basic human needs which benefit low-moderate income persons. The project chosen to address these objectives, HOUSING REHABILITATION AND MODIFICATION, is located in the UNINCORPORATED areas of SABINE COUNTY. Total project cost will be \$ 250,000.00 (D.O.C. \$ 250,000.00). The Application will be on file for review by local citizens at the COUNTY JUDGE'S OFFICE SABINE COUNTY COURTHOUSE each work day during regular working hours (8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.), starting September 14, 1989. Submission date for the application is September 14, 1989.

All residents of the County of Sabine are invited to attend this hearing and to review the Application and to express their views and make comments both written and verbal on all aspects of the program and the Application. Written comments can be sent to David J. Waxman, Inc., P. O. Box 900, Jasper, Texas 75951. Facilities for the handicapped will be provided.
