

Monday, April 9, 1990, the Honorable Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Royce Smith. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes for the called meeting for March 19th were read and approved. Commissioner Billy McGee made the motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel, and motion carried.

Minutes for the regular meeting for March 26th were read.. Commissioner McGee made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to approve these minutes. Motion carried.

Commissioner Billy McGee.. made<sup>a</sup> motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Conn, to rescind the motion made March 12, which read "to approve the voting place at Thomas Johnson after Justice Department approval." He then changed the motion to read "to accept a voting place upon recommendation by the Justice Department." Motion carried.

County reports were presented for inspection. Those presented were from the county Treasurer, Tax Collector, JUstices of the Peace, and County and District Clerks' fees. Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to approve reports. Motion carried.

County bills were inspected for payment. Motion was made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to approve payment. Motion carried.

The Court had asked from what fund Sheriff Greer planned to pay for light bars for Sheriff department. Dispatcher Tom Philips said they will be paid for out of the equipment section of budget.

Two bids were received for phone system for Sheriff Department. One was from Contel for \$660.00 plus \$117.00 per month. The other was from A. G. Mott, for \$475.00, plus \$93.39 per month. Sheriff Greer accepted the bid from Contel because he feels faster emergency service would be more readily available because of a number of local resident servicemen.

Keith Denby was present representing Motorola telephone equipment for the Sheriff Department. His bid was for 60,000.00, \$7,300.00 of this due during this budget year. L.T.S./G.E.'s bid for installation and equipment is \$63,320.45. Both companies offer tax exempt lease purchase. Motorola Communications is the vendor of choice by the Sabine County Sheriff Department.

Court recessed for 10 minutes.

Court reconvened at 10:00 A. M. Since Motorola price is ~~is~~ valid for 60 days, Commissioner Cox made the motion to table this until our next regular meeting. Commissioner McGee seconded, and motion carried.

Sabine County Fire Fighters was on the agenda, but no one was present.

9-1-1 Committee appointments were made. Commissioner Cox made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to appoint two from each Commissioner precinct, and 1 at large. This will enhance mapping and measuring roads and also naming or numbering all County roads. Names submitted were: Precinct 4 - Carl and Katy Blair, Precinct 3, Patsy Dickerson and Gayla McBride, Precinct 2 - A. G. Mott and Tracy Lane, Person at large is Bill Barcheers. Commissioner Precinct 1 did not have his names ready. Commissioner Cox made the motion, seconded by Commissioner McGee, to accept names submitted. Motion carried. They will report to the Court in about 30 days.

Names for the childrens Service Board were submitted by Judge Smith. Motion was made by Commissioner McGee, seconded by Commissioner McDaniel, to accept names submitted. Motion carried. "See attached list."

Two bids were presented for Sheriff department car; one from Hemphill Motor Company for \$13,678.00, and one from Greenville Ford, Mercury, at Greenville, Texas for \$ 13,233.00. Commissioner McGee made the motion to accept the bid from Hemphill Motor company. This was seconded by Commissioner Conn, and motion carried.

County Clerk, Nadine gary presented her certificate from County and District Clerks' Association stating that as of December 31, 1989, she has successfully completed the requirements for continuing education as prescribed in Section 51.604 of the Government Code. Commissioner Billy McGee made the motion to approve this certificate as a matter of record. Commissioner Carlin McDaniel seconded the motion, and motion carried.



Subject: Choice of vendor for installation of new radio system for Sabine County Sheriff's Department.

Motorola Communications is the vendor of choice by the Sabine County Sheriff's Department. Motorola's proposal for the system was more complete, including range of operations. System operation was fully described and accurate engineering range prediction maps provided which showed 5% more guaranteed coverage than the other vendor's bid.

Motorola's proposal also included increasing the tower height on the existing fire department tower behind the Sheriff's Department, repainting the tower, and installing the required light kit at the bid price.

Motorola offered extended pricing on mobiles and portables for a period of 150 days from installation should another entity want to take advantage of the bid price. The other vendor offered 90 days.

Delivery of equipment by Motorola would be four weeks after new frequency is known. Delivery of equipment by the other vendor would be 14 weeks.

The Motorola equipment is compatible with equipment used by surrounding law enforcement agencies and the scrambled signal technology on Motorola equipment is identical to equipment used by D. P. S. Narcotics.

Both vendors agreed to post 100% performance bond on the project. Both vendors agreed to assist in acquiring 2 new frequencies for S. O. outside the bid price. Motorola estimate of this cost is approximately \$1,500.00 for both frequencies. The only other extended cost for the project outside the bid is for an electricians services to provide 2 electrical recepticals in the storage building behind S. O. and the use of his services to tie the radio system into the emergency generator system at the S. O.
