

Friday, January 18, 1991, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a called session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Richard Smith. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last three meetings were read by County Clerk, Nadine Gary. Motion was made by Commissioner Cox and seconded by Commissioner Conn to approve minutes for December 20, 1990. Motion carried. Commissioner Cox made the motion to approve minutes for December 28. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried. Commissioner Conn made the motion to approve minutes for meeting January 2. Commissioner Smith seconded, and motion carried.

Judge Smith informed the Court he will exercise his right to vote on all issues, and not just to break a tie. This way the public will know how he stands.

Commissioner Carlin McDaniel gave a report on Regional Solid Waste. We were expecting to pay Sabine River Authority approximately \$20,000.00 engineering fee and be able to start on project in 3 or 4 months. Sam Collins with Sabine River Authority was present at the meeting, and said the engineering fee could be as much as \$100,000.00 to \$120,000.00, and may be 18 months before study is done. Since we have neither time or money, we may go with Angelina Neches River Authority. Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, to table the signing of this resolution. All voted for.

Commissioner Lynn Smith made the motion to hire a part time secretary for J. P. Prct. 3, Daniel Featherston. The City of Pineland has a part time secretary who works in the City Office and can work with him and Prct. 4 J. P., Bobby White. This motion failed for lack of a second.

Commissioner McDaniel then made the motion to table this until our meeting January 25th. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

User fees for persons who dump garbage in the County Landfills was discussed, but no action was taken.

Re-appoint County committees will be an agenda item January 28th.

Commissioner McDaniel suggested checking into the buying of 33 gallon size colored garbage bags to use instead of paying fees at dumps. Also he will check into the cost of a chipper for County, and to sell compose.

Clarice Clark, J. P. # 5, met with the Court requesting the purchase of a typewriter and filing cabinet for her office use. She found a filing cabinet for \$224.00 and a typewriter for \$431.10. Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion to approve her request. Commissioner carlin McDaniel seconded. Motion failed, with Commissioner Conn and Commissioner McDaniel voting for, and Commissioners Smith, Cox, and Judge Smith voting against. J. P. Clark will check for a cheaper price. She will again be on the agenda January 25th.

Court recessed 15 minutes, and re-convened at 10:25.

Motion was made by commissioner Conn, and seconded by Commissioner Cox, to pay County road hands \$51.10 per day, and add \$60.50 twice a month for the additional \$121.00 salary. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Jimmy Conn and seconded by Commissioner Lynn Smith, to request County Treasurer, Ollie Faye Sparks, to transfer \$4,793.56 from R&B precinct 2 to the General Fund. This was an interest payment/~~made~~ ^{which was paid out of the General Fund} in October, 1990 for Prct. 2.

Motion carried, with all voting for. Commissioner Smith asked that this be taken from line item for machinery and equipment in his budget.

Commissioner Smith made the motion to renew a time warrant for precinct 2 by paying \$5,000.00 plus interest, which is \$1,268.29. Total payment made is \$ 6,268.29, and leaves a balance due of \$5,581.26. All voted for.

Commissioner Lynn Smith will contact Roy Blake Insurance adjuster concerning a \$5,476.26 bill for motor grader repair from Richmond Garage in Burkeville.

Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Cox, to waive the agenda in order to discuss the 2% Adminstrative fee the County can add for collecting the insurance premium for previous employees who stay on the group health insurance through Cobra. Motion carried.

Commissioner McDaniel made the motion to add the 2 % administrative fee. Commissioner Smith seconded, and motion carried.

Keith Denby and Sheriff Greer will be on the agenda January 25th concerning the Motorola tower.

Rev. Ellis Kemper was present requesting the court to encourage more minority representation in local government.

Court recessed until 1:00 P.M.

We can get a TQ-220 model Royal typewriter for \$89.00 and a 4-drawer legal size filing cabinet for \$149.00.

Budget deficit will be an agenda item for Jan. 25.

Commissioner Conn made the motion that court adjourn. Commissioner McDaniel seconded, and motion carried.
