

Monday, May 13, 1991, the Sabine county Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Judge Smith called the meeting to order; Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved. Commissioner Chester Cox made the motion, seconded by Commissioner James Conn, to approve these minutes. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to approve monthly reports. Motion carried.

Mrs. Edith McCauley, Administrator of Sabine county Hospital, was present concerning radio problems with the hospital and Sheriff department since the frequency change. This will again be discussed at our meeting May 28th.

Motion was made by Commissioner Cox, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to approve resolution enrolling in State Purchasing contracts. Motion carried. "See attached exhibit"

Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel to approve the re-creation of 5 deed records in the County Clerk's office. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded, and motion carried.

No action was taken at this time on listing of County bills.

Sam Fling, from Six Mile area, was present concerning dumping trash on a public road. This garbage belonged to another person, and she had been filed on, since her name was in it. He stated he was new in the county, and did not know where the dump was. Precinct 2 Commissioner Lynn Smith, stated if this was true, he will drop the charges filed. No action was taken.

After a 10 minute recess, Max Goodhart presented his request that penalty and interest be dropped from his delinquent taxes. He sold this property 5 years ago, but re-possessed it, and found \$199.58 penalty and interest was due on delinquent taxes. No action was taken.

Representatives of Sabine Investment asked the Court to waive the agenda to present two plats for LaGuna Shores. Commissioner Smith made the motion to waive the agenda. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried. The plats were presented, but no action was taken. This will be an agenda item Friday, May 17. Other items for this date will be Citizens Review Committee and Personnel Policies and Procedures.

Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner Smith, to reject resolution supporting extension of FM 92 in Tyler county. Motion carried.



Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion to approve resolution supporting approval of the application to drill on the Yellowpine Ranger District of the Sabine National Forest, and urge Ranger Hawkins to make a decision to that effect. Commissioner Lynn Smith seconded, and motion carried. "See attached resolution."

Re-districting update was discussed. Judge Smith informed the Court there is a public hearing scheduled for Tuesday, May 28th at 7:00 P. M. This hearing will be in the district Court room.

Commissioner Lynn Smith made the motion to adopt landfill fees proposal and start tipping fees as soon as possible. Commissioner McDaniel seconded. Motion failed, with Commissioner Smith and McDaniel voting for, and Commissioner Jimmy Conn, Chester Cox, and Judge Smith voting against.

Commissioner Smith named W. A. (Bill) Whiddon of Fairmont to the 9-1-1 mapping committee to replace Stephen Gray. 9-1-1 Committee will be an agenda item Friday, May 17.

Judge Richard Smith informed the Court that Workers Comp. now requires a drug abuse policy. Motion was made by Commissioner Conn to adopt a drug abuse policy. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried. "See attached".

Court recessed until 1:30 P. M.


When Court re-convened budget deficit was discussed. Commissioner Chester Cox made the motion to transfer ad valorem and sales tax money in the amount of \$72,601.24 to the Salary Fund. Commissioner Carlin McDaniel seconded. After discussion, Commissioner Cox withdrew his motion.

An agenda item Friday, May 17th will be consider order directing publication of notice of Intention to issue time warrants, Series 1991. Other items for this date will be "discuss liability insurance, dispose of 5 acres for landfill site, and consider purchase of an air conditioner for transmitter room."

Motion was made by Commissioner Cox to transfer entire 15% of ad valorem tax and sales tax money for now and entire fisical year into the General Fund. Commissioner Conn seconded, and all voted for.


Commissioner Cox made the motion to pay bills except for ones pulled. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried.





Friday, May 17, 1991, the Sabine county Commissioners' Court met in a called session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Smith. Commissioner Lynn Smith led the opening prayer.

Mike Strotherwith Sabine Investment presented two plats for approval. LaGuna Shores, Section 4 and 8. Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith to accept plat for section 8. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried. Commissioner Smith then made the motion to accept approximately 1,000 feet of road in section 8 as County maintained road. Commissioner McDaniel seconded; and motion carried.

Commissioner chester Cox presented two names for the Citizens Review Committee. They are Mary Davidson and Earl Morris.

Judge Smith gave an update on our Policy and Procedure Manuel. He reported the work is proceeding well. We have been meeting once a week.

Will Smith resigned from the 9-1-1 Committee. Commississioner Cox appointed D.B. Chance to the committee.

Judge Smith informed the Court he talked with our banker concerning time warrants for the County. Judge Smith recommended we make one time warrant per month to cover salaries and payment of bills. Rate of interest will be prime plus two. At the end of the year, pay what we can, and remainder will be charged to debt service. Motion was made by Commissioner Cox to accept this recommendation. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried.

Commissioner cox made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Conn, to drop all liability insurance except that on County automobiles. Motion carried, with three voting for, and Commissioner McDaniel voting against.


Commissioner Lynn Smith will check with Temple-Inland concerning trading 5 acres of land in Pineland for land in Hemphill.



Agenda items for Tuesday, May 28th are: posting agenda, Springhill Subdivision, East Tex Communications, and Keith Denby.






INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

for

TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES EPA GROUP PERMIT POOL

This Agreement, entered into by and between the Texas Association of Counties (hereinafter call "TAC") and Sabine County (hereinafter call "Pool Member") shall be effective as of the date hereinafter shown.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Sabine County wishes to participate as a member in a Pool formed under the Interlocal Cooperation Act being organized pursuant to the recommendation of the TAC to assist Texas Counties in meeting storm water permit requirements imposed by EPA regulations issued on November 16, 1990; the deadline for filing Part I of the group application to EPA is March 18, 1991; the deadline to complete and return Form A is March 13, 1991; the information provided will be used to determine whether each facility is eligible to participate in the group; and

WHEREAS, the \$500.00 fee (per facility) covers the costs for Part I. of the group application; a separate fee and Form A, will be required for each facility; the costs of Part II have not been determined at this time and will be in addition to the Part I application fee; acceptance of TAC's group application is a discretionary matter to be determined by EPA; there is no assurance that such acceptance will be issued by EPA; and

WHEREAS, quantitative data including sampling and testing of the storm water will be required for 10% of the facilities covered by the group application or a minimum of 10 facilities, whichever is greater; and the facility described in Form A may be reviewed and considered by the group for development of the quantitative data, including stormwater sampling and testing, that is required to support the group application.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said parties hereby contract and agree as follows:

- 1) TAC will act as the "entity" permitted within the EPA regulations for the purpose of making a group application for a storm water permit covering the facilities of Pool Member as specifically described in the appropriate information form.
- 2) Pool Member will pay \$500.00 per facility for Part I to TAC upon receipt of a bill from TAC.
- 3) Pool Member will provide to TAC all information required for the filing of Parts I and II of the application.

4) Costs for Part II will be allocated equally among all facility sites.

5) TAC is authorized to employ all necessary engineers, attorneys, accountants and other specialists as may be required.

6) The Environmental Protection Agency's approval is discretionary and acceptance cannot be assured.

7) Pool Member shall make the payments under this contract from current revenues available to Pool Member.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY

OF

SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS

I. Policy Statement

Sabine County recognizes that alcohol and drug abuse in the workplace has become a major concern. We believe that by reducing drug and alcohol abuse we can improve the safety, health and productivity of our employees. It is our intent to provide a safe, healthy, drug free workplace for all employees, prevent accidents and comply with all applicable State and Federal Laws. For the purpose of this policy, the term "Drug", wherever it appears in this policy, refers to all substances enumerated in section II.

II. Prohibited Activities

It shall be prohibited for any employee to use, sell, possess, purchase, manufacture, distribute or be under the influence of any alcohol, inhalants, illegal or illicit drugs, or controlled substances. Prescription drugs may only be used pursuant to a valid prescription and upon express doctor's orders. This prohibition is to be in effect at all times on company premises or while on company business.

III. Consequences of Violations

Violation of this Substance Abuse Policy will result in one of the following forms of corrective action: Termination, suspension, probation, oral warning or written warning. Failure to assist in an investigation on possible violations may also result in corrective action being taken.

IV. Treatment Programs and Employee Insurance

While we do not sponsor or endorse any specific drug treatment programs, such programs are available through public and private health care facilities in our area. Affected employees are encouraged to seek assistance for themselves and their dependents. The Group Health Insurance offered to employees and their dependents may provide limited coverage for expenses related to drug treatment programs.

V. Education and Training Programs

We do not offer, nor require participation in drug and alcohol abuse education and training programs. However, various public and private facilities in our area offer such programs and affected employees are encouraged to seek assistance.

VI. Drug Testing

We do not require drug testing as a condition of employment. We may, however, require drug testing for just cause. Just cause includes, but is not limited to work related accidents, reasonable suspicion, direct observation, or arrest or conviction on a drug related violation.

POLICY APPROVED

SABINE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT

It will be prohibited for any employee of the County to use, possess, or be under the influence of any controlled substance or alcohol while on duty. This prohibition applies to all employees, regardless of their position or the nature of their work. Any violation of this policy may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

Employees who are found to be under the influence of a controlled substance or alcohol while on duty may be subject to random drug testing. The results of such testing may be used as evidence in disciplinary proceedings.

The County will not pay for any drug testing or treatment costs for an employee who is found to be under the influence of a controlled substance or alcohol while on duty. The employee may be required to pay for any such costs.

This policy is intended to ensure the safety and health of all employees and the public. It is the policy of the County to maintain a drug-free workplace.







RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, two exploratory oil and/or gas wells in Compartment 134 and 122 on the Yellowpine Ranger District of the Sabine National Forest have been proposed; and

WHEREAS, District Ranger Isaac W. Hawkins has requested public input regarding any site specific concerns which may be held; and

WHEREAS, said public input is needed prior to Ranger Hawkins making a decision on whether or not to approve the operator submitted Surface Use Plans of Operations pertaining to the Applications to Drill; and

WHEREAS, both national and local policy is to facilitate oil and gas leasing, exploration and development on the National Forests and Grasslands, including the proposed project areas; and

WHEREAS, Ranger Hawkins' decision will take into account whether or not the proposed location is environmentally acceptable and what mitigation measures will be required; and

WHEREAS, standard clauses will be utilized for any and all exploration or development proposals and that these standard clauses contain requirements designed to protect the surface resources, and said requirements can be readily implemented or enforced by the U. S. Government;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Sabine County Commissioners Court fully supports approval of the Applications to Drill and urges Ranger Hawkins to make a decision to that effect.

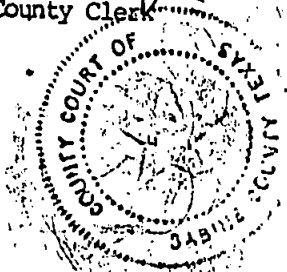
