Meeting was called to order by Judge Richard Smith. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved. Commissioner Chester Cox made the motion to approve minutes for May 28th. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried. Commissioner Cox then made the motion to approve minutes for June 3rd. Commissioner Smith seconded, and motion carried.

Judge Richard Smith explained that our N-Group contract expired August, 1990.

The correction Warranty Deed from Temple-Inland was accepted for recording.

Sheriff Blane Greer was present for a question and answer session. Sheriff Greer will contact Two Sisters' Restaurant to see if they will send the monthly Board Bill to the County instead of him. The Court ^{was} agreed to reimburse Sheriff Greer for a \$1036.00 drug bill. This/for purchasing drugs and paying informants. Sheriff department overtime was discussed, but no action was taken.

Walter Wallace was on the agenda concerning moving culverts on his property. He asked to go on record as wanting nothing done to damage his property by moving culverts.

Christmas and New Years' Holidays were set. Commissioner Chester Cox made the motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Conn to set December 23, 24, and 25th for Christmas, and December 31st and January 1, 1992 for New Years'. Motion carried.

Debt Service was discussed. It was explained anything we take more than a year to pay for should be put in debt service. Put into debt service each year the amount we intend to pay that year.

Maurice Patterson with the Citizens Review Committee gave a recommendation made by the Committee. "See attached exhibit."

Commissioner Lynn Smith presented a petition with 18 signatures requesting the roads in Springhill Subdivision be dedicated to Sabine county and assumed as County Roads. "See attached." Commissioner Smith recommended we accept roads in Springhill Subdivision as County maintained roads. Commissioner McDaniel seconded, and motion carried.

M.H.M.R. Pledge was tabled until our meeting June 24th.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner Chester Cox, to advertise for bids to sell a 1981-4 door Oldsmobile - Bid opening to be July 8th. Motion carried.

Commissioner Cox made the motion to renew our County Health Insurance with Guardian, effective July 1, without going out for bids. Deductable will be raised from \$250.00 to \$450.00- Life

Insurance will be decreased from \$25,000.00 to \$10,000.00. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Conn, and motion carried.


No action was taken on Texas Community Development Program.


The Court agreed to pay \$710.12 to the Texas Department of Health for State Landfill fees for the first quarter of 1990.




Commissioner Cox made the motion to pay bills except one from Leroy Smith Garage and M.H.M.R. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried.



WHEREAS the people of Sabine County have joined together to introduce our young people to the sport of fishing in an effort help avert them from becoming involved in drug abuse,


NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard Smith, Judge of Sabine County, Texas, do hereby proclaim June 14-15, 1991 as:

We have completed the annual review of your plan.


Commissioner McDaniel made a motion to pay the bills except the MHMR pledge with a second from Commissioner Smith. Motion carried.


