RESOLVED, that an official of the Lessee be, and is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to sign on its behalf the Lease and any schedules, notes, UCC financing statements or other instruments issued under the provision of the Lease and any other instrument or document which may be necessary in connection with fulfillment of the provisions of the Lease.
RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, this Lease be and is hereby designated a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" includable within the ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) of the aggregate issues designated as "qualified tax-exampt obligations" for the calendar year within which this Lease is entered into.
RESOLVED, that Lessee shall not designate more than ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) of tax-exempt obligations during the current calendar year as qualified tax-exempt obligations and Lessee, does not reasonably expect to issue more than ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) of tax-exempt obligations during the current calendar year.
