Friday, August 23, 1991, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a called session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Meeting was called to order by Judge Richard Smith. Judge Smith also led the opening prayer.

Court again worked on 1991-92 budget. Precinct budgets were discussed at length. Minimum wage is \$4.25. Commissioners have the disgression to pay road hands from \$4.25 to \$7.08 per hour. Dump hands are paid out of Solid Waste fund.

Court recessed until 2:00 P. M., then re-convened for redistricting. Committee members present were Jack Lane, Carl Garrett, Melvin Wilson, George Booth and Vollie Grace. Judge Smith recommended we adopt Plan C. Jack Lane recommended the Commissioners' Court adopt Plan C over Plan A. Melvin Wilson seconded. 4 voted for; Mr. Grace and Lonnie Davis voted against. (Mr. Davis voted by proxey.)

Motion was made by Commissioner Lynn Smith to adopt Plan C as drafted using Attorney General Computor. Commissioner Carlin McDaniel seconded, and motion carried, with all voting for.

Precinct budgets were considered. The following splits were approved: Precinct 1, 2, and 3 will receive \$154,488.00 each, with Precinct 4 receiving \$172,290.00, making a total of \$635,754.00. The percentage split is Prct. 1, 2, and 3 is 24.3%, and Prct. 4 gets 27.1%. Commissioner Cox made the motion to approve these figures as presented. Commissioner Smith seconded, and motion carried.
