

Monday, November 25, 1991, the Sabine County Commissioners' Court met in a regular session at 8:30 A. M., with the following members present:

Judge Richard Smith called meeting to order. Brother Clarence Howell led the opening prayer.

Motion was made by Commissioner Carlin McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Jimmy Conn, to approve Tax Assessor/Collector's report. Motion carried.

# 3 - Sidewalk on West side of Courthouse: Judge Smith informed the Court the Historical Society will pay for repairs for this part of sidewalk. They have a bid for \$3,800.00.

# 4- Mrs. Ollie Hall and Dick Horn presented a petition signed by 140 registered voters from Rosevine, protesting the moving of their voting box. Judge Smith explained the reason for this change, and that the submission has been sent to the Justice department. Nothing can be done at this time.

Commissioner Jimmy Conn made the motion to appoint Commissioner Carlin McDaniel as a member to R.C. and D. Council. Commissioner Chester Cox seconded, and motion carried.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

#6 - County Extension Agent funding: Sabine County was asked to pay \$2,500.00 annual salary, plus \$1,200.00 travel, and share with San Augustine County. No action was taken.

H. W. Gentis met with the Court concerning .5 of a mile of road in Lakeside Park Subdivision. He presented a petition requesting the County to accept it as a County maintained road. Commissioner Conn made the motion to accept this road. Commissioner Cox seconded, and motion carried.

# 11 - Commissioner Cox made the motion to split R&B interest money of \$11,439.24 equally four ways. Commissioner Conn seconded, and motion carried.

Dawn Procell informed the Court she had a prowler at her house about 11:30 P. M., November 6. She called the Sheriff's Department, and was told by Doug Fletcher that because of "cut backs" there was only one deputy on duty, and no one to send. Dispatcher Johnnie Palmer did get her and take her to her mother's, but no one investigated. Billy Don Sparks was the deputy on duty. Sheriff Greer talked with Dawn concerning this Friday, Nov. 22nd. Dawn also said she is afraid to stay home at night because her husband works off and this is still going on. No action was taken by the court.

Due to Christmas holidays, the regular 4th Monday commissioners' court day in December will be changed to Thursday, December 19th.

# 9-Easement to City of Hemphill will be an agenda item at our next regular meeting.

# 12 - Discuss location of Solid waste transfer station: The court agreed we should have a transfer station in the county. Commissioner McDaniel suggested this be on our property in Hemphill; it will be more centrally located. No action was taken.

County Attorney, Dwight McDaniel, presented Judge Smith a letter concerning the land swap with Temple for equal value. "See attached."

The Court discussed a letter Judge Smith had received from Claunch and Hallman, consultants from Nacogdoches, who worked with us on the redistricting plan. The Commissioners had questioned a bill for \$8,609.95 from their firm. They agreed to pay the bill, but were offended by the letter, and Judge Smith will write an answer to that effect. "See attached letter from consultants."


After a 15 minute recess, personnel policy manuel was reviewed.


Policy Manuel and voting precincts will be items for a called meeting Tuesday, December 3rd.


Commissioner Smith made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Cox, to pay accounts and salaries. Motion carried.




Meeting was called to order by Judge Richard Smith; Commissioner Carlin McDaniel led the opening prayer.



Question (Commissioner Carlin McDaniel)-What procedure must the County undergo in order to trade real estate for equal value with a private corporation (Temple-EastTex)?


Answer - The exchange of real property owned by the County must be done strictly according to the statutes as contained in the Local Government Code.

**§ 263.006. Exchange of Real Property**

(a) The commissioners court of a county, by an order entered in its minutes, may authorize the exchange of an interest in real property owned by the county for an interest in real property owned by an individual, private partnership or corporation, or other private entity, to be used for one or more public purposes for which a county otherwise may acquire land. The exchange transaction may include a partial cash payment.

(b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), before the commissioners court exchanges an interest in real property under this section, notice that the county will consider offers for an exchange of the interest in real property must be published in English in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the real property is located and in the county that owns the interest if not the same county. The notice must be published once a week for three consecutive weeks before the date of the exchange, with the date of the first publication being before the 20th day before the date of the exchange.

(c) The county shall obtain an appraisal of the fair market value of the interest in real property owned and being exchanged by the county, and the appraisal is conclusive for purposes of this section of the value so determined. An exchange may not be made under this section for a total consideration, including cash and interest in real property, that is less than the fair market value of the interest in real property being exchanged by the county. The commissioners court may reject any and all offers made under this section.

(d) An exchange of an interest in real property originally acquired by the county for street, right-of-way, or easement purposes as consideration for the acquisition of another interest in real property for street, right-of-way, or easement purposes is not subject to the notice requirements of Subsection (b) but is subject to the appraisal required by Subsection (c), whether or not the exchange transaction includes a partial cash payment.

(e) This section does not apply to the exchange of an interest in real property owned by a county for an interest in real property owned by the United States, this state, or a municipality or other political subdivision of this state.

Dear Judge Smith:

We received your letter regarding our request for payment for redistricting services rendered. We will be unable to attend your meeting on November 25, 1991; and therefore submit this letter for your consideration.

We regret our submitted bill exceeded the estimate. However, we did indicate to the court in our original letter that we billed by the hours actually worked. More hours were required for the project than anticipated because of numerous requests made by various county officials and were beyond our reasonable expectations. Not only did we do as requested, we also did the work in a timely fashion. A listing of work not anticipated at the beginning of the project includes the following:

- a) analysis of Plan B as submitted by the Justice of the Peace to determine the constitutionality and workability
- b) verification of the boundaries of Plan C and preparation of a suitable map of the plan with recognizable boundaries and not just a vague computer map which would not be satisfactory for submission purposes or public display
- c) computation of voter registration rates by race for each voting box, commissioner precinct, JP precinct, constable precinct past and present; the county clerk usually provides this information, could not do so, and is a requirement for the submission package to the Department of Justice
- d) a revision of our plan prior to open submission to the court--done at the request of Judge Smith and Commissioner Smith
- e) three meetings in Nacogdoches (actually a savings to the county since we did not have to travel to Hemphill)
- f) advisory committee appointed after our proposal was accepted; caused additional meetings with the committee

We have been involved in redistricting projects with cities, counties, and school districts for 16 years and have never presented such a detailed bill as we have already provided for you. In 16 years no political entity has questioned, challenged, or delayed payment for our services. We did not request any advance for our services as did some competitors and our final bill still is quite less than the original bids of our competitors.

We notified Judge Smith when we were approaching the original bid figure, and obviously had uncompleted requests and work to do. We were told to proceed and told the information was being shared with the court.

We understand your concern and cautiousness with the county's resources, but we have done the work in good faith, done what was requested, and did not do any extra work unless it was requested. By tabling the decision to pay us and delaying the payment is unprofessional. You should handle this matter in a timely fashion as you expected us to perform in a timely fashion.

We expect prompt payment for our services rendered on behalf of Sabine County.

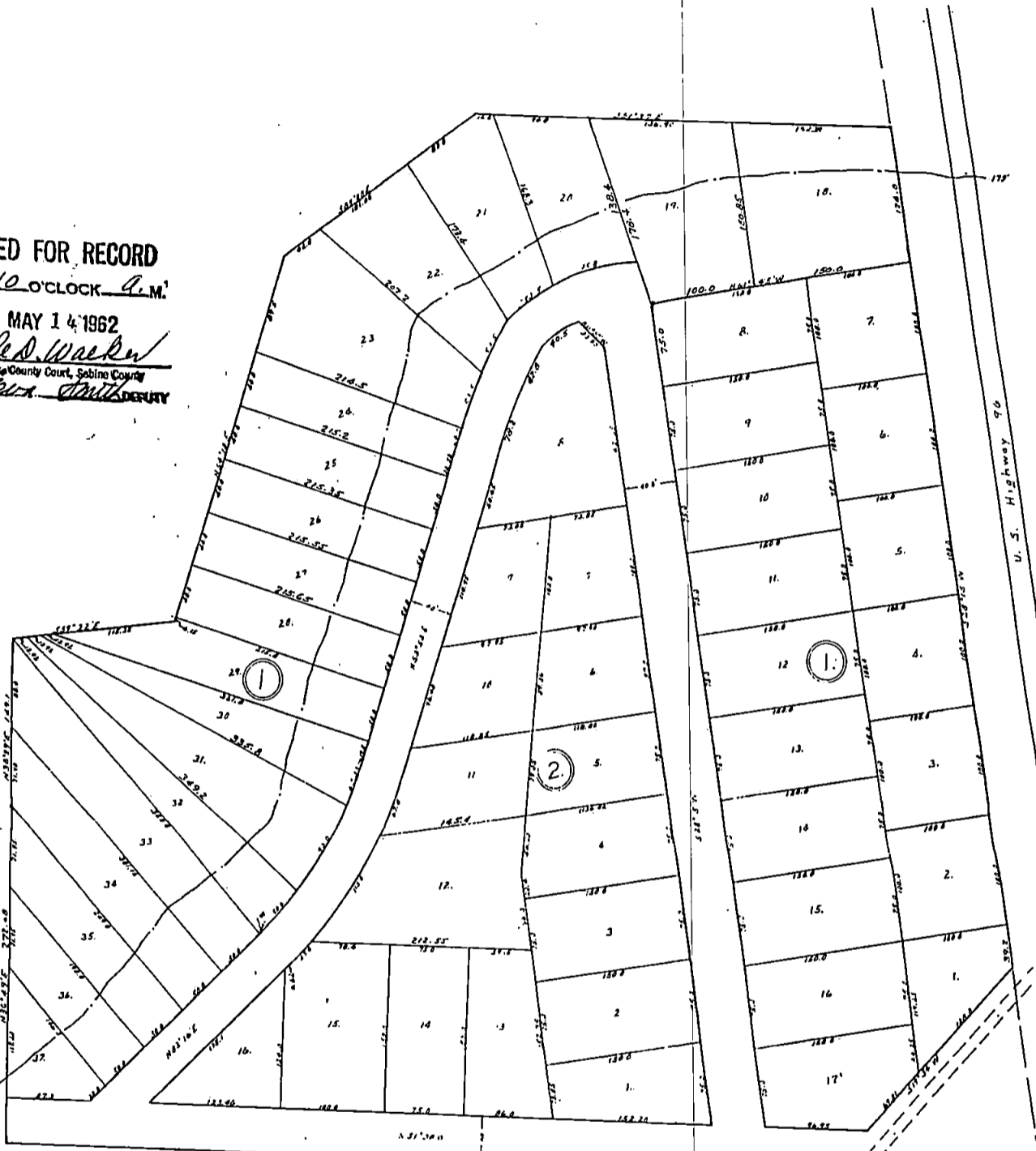

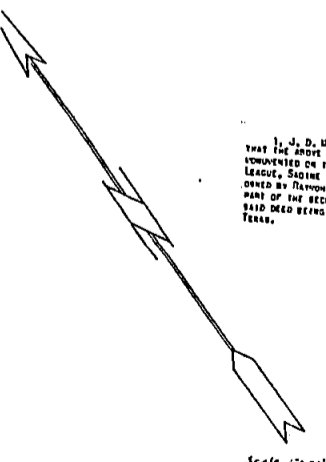
